LABOR, COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY

§ 13-17-40. South Carolina Research Authority

Members: 24 trustees that includes the following ex officio members: President of the Council of Private Colleges of South Carolina, Chairman of the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education, President of Clemson University, President of the Medical University of South Carolina, President of South Carolina State College, President of the University of South Carolina, Director of Savannah River National Laboratory, President of Francis Marion University, Chairman of the State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education, Governor of South Carolina or his designee, Chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee's designee, Chairman of the Senate Finance Committee's designee, and the Secretary of Commerce or his designee. The remaining 10 trustees must be elected by the board of trustees from a list of nominees submitted by an ad hoc committee named by the chairman and composed of the members serving as elected trustees; and each of the Congressional Districts must have at least one of the 10.

Term: 4 years, and half expire every 2 years. An elected trustee may not serve more than 2 consecutive 4-year elected terms.

§ 40-57-40. S.C. Real Estate Commission

9 members - 6 members who are professionally engaged in the active practice of real estate, 1 elected from each of the six congressional districts by a majority of house members and senators of those congressional districts; 2 lay members appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate; 1 at-large member in the active practice of real estate elected by the 8 other commission members.

Term - 4 years

§ 40-59-10. South Carolina Residential Builders Commission

7 members - Appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of Senate, 1 from each of the six congressional districts, 1 from the state at-large; 4 of those members must have been actively engaged in residential building for a period of at least five years before the date of their appointment, and who must be recommended to the Governor by the South Carolina Home Builders Association; 2 must be lay members not engaged in the business.

Term - 4 years

§ 40-81-50. State Athletic Commission

8 members - Appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate, 1 from each Congressional District, 1 physician and 1 at-large

Term - 4 years

§ 41-43-30. South Carolina Jobs - Economic Development Authority -- Board of Directors; § 41-43-40.

9 members - Appointed by the Governor upon the advice and consent of the Senate, 1 from each Congressional District and 1 from state at-large, Governor and the Chairman of the State Development Board serve as ex officio members-Term - 3 years
