

As prescribed by Act 151 of the 116th session of the South Carolina General Assembly, the SCEIS Executive Oversight Committee respectfully submits its annual report on the implementation of the South Carolina Enterprise Information System (SCEIS). This is a summary level report. More detailed information is available if needed.

Current Status

In August 2005, the Master Agreement with BearingPoint, the State's initial prime integrator, expired. The State took a two-step approach to selecting a new integrator. First, the State entered a contract with SAP Consulting to review, evaluate and identify gaps in the work that was performed by BearingPoint. SAP Consulting also assisted the State in closing all of the major gaps in this work, to include updating and refining the "blueprint" for realization of the SCEIS Project. Second, the State issued a request for proposals and, through an extensive evaluation process, selected Deloitte Consulting as the new prime integrator. The State executed a Master Agreement with Deloitte Consulting in February 2006 and finalized a Statement of Work for the first phase of the SCEIS Project in June 2006. This phase includes implementation of the Finance and Materials Management Modules of SAP in 19 state agencies. This includes central government entities as well as a group of agencies currently using the BARS accounting system. Implementation of this first phase is scheduled for Summer 2007. During the period, the State's infrastructure contractor, Hewlett-Packard, also completed the "build out" of the hardware landscapes. Hewlett-Packard is now in the process of upgrading these landscapes to the latest version of the SAP software, ERP 2005. The State has also initiated a project to select an additional contractor to provide imaging software, hardware and services for the SCEIS Project. Demonstrations have been completed and a contractor is scheduled to be selected in February 2007. The Project remains within the overall budget, schedule and scope as defined in Act 151 and the SCEIS Business Case Study published in 2003.

Scope

The scope the SCEIS project continues to be the implementation of Finance, Materials Management (procurement), Human Resources, Payroll and Budgeting for the enterprise. As prescribed by Act 151, the enterprise includes all state agencies, with the exception of lump-sum agencies, the General Assembly or its respective branches or its committees, Legislative Council, and the Office of Legislative Printing and Information Technology Resources. The scope of the project remains unchanged.

Schedule

Act 151 calls for full implementation of SCEIS within 5 years of its passage, not later than June of 2010. While the plan for the final date remains unchanged, the SCEIS team, working with the Deloitte Consulting, has revised the detail rollout plan to remain within the time frames for completion of the project. The revised plan reduced the number of project phases from the 17 (10 FI/MM/Budget 6 HR/PR, 1 Statewide Budgeting) to 11 (6 FI/MM, 4 HR/PR, 1 Statewide Budgeting). Attached for reference is the revised plan that was reviewed by the SCEIS Technical Advisory Subcommittee and approved by the SCEIS Executive Oversight Committee.

Budget

The SCEIS project plan continues to remain within the overall budget of \$62.8 million for implementation. The implementation budget plan for the project remains unchanged. This plan identified the following sources of funds: 1) \$47.1 in agency funds 2) \$11.2 in one time appropriations and 3) \$4.5 million in other funds. To date, the Executive Oversight Committee approved the process for agencies to transfer their shares based on the kick off and successful implementation of the Finance and Materials Management rollout, the State has appropriated the \$11.2 million in one time money, and \$1.875 in other funds have been applied to the project. The SCEIS project will continue to pursue alternative funding to cover the \$2.7 million gap in other funding.
