**RESOLUTION #R2015-008**

**A RESOLUTION PURPOSING PURCHASE OF A BUILDING FOR VOTER REGISTRATION AND ELECTIONS, OTHER COUNTY AND STATE DEPARTMENTS, AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO.**

**WHEREAS**, Additional office space is needed for Voter Registration and Elections, as well as other County and State Departments, and

**WHEREAS**, a building on Main Street is available for purchase to satisfy these office space needs; and

**WHEREAS**, this building can economically satisfy these space needs into the future.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, Be it resolved by Anderson County Council in meeting duly assembled that:

1. The Anderson County Council approves in concept the purchase of the Main Street Building and assigns to the County Administrator the responsibility to conduct appropriate due diligence to protect the interest of Anderson County.
2. The Anderson County council upon satisfactory completion of due diligence authorizes the County Administrator to execute all necessary documents for purchase of the property.
3. All orders and negotiations in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict only, repealed and rescinded.
4. Should any part or portion of this resolution be deemed unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such finding shall not affect the remainder hereof all of which is hereby deemed separable.
5. This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon enactment
