## SUMMARY REPORT

Meeting of Commission on Higher Education, July 12, 1984

### STUDY OF PROJECTED ENROLLMENTS

The Commission approved a study of projected enrollments and space utilization at the colleges and universities.

### LICENSURE RENEWAL

Requests for renewal of licensure to operate in South Carolina were approved for the following institutions: Shaw University (Raleigh, N.C.), two-year provisional; Gardner-Webb College (Boiling Springs, N.C.), two-year provisional; and Webster University (St. Louis, Mo.), regular five-year license.

### APPROPRIATION FORMULA

The Commission approved an appropriation formula for funding residency programs within the Consortium of Community Teaching Hospitals.

### STUDY

Also approved was a Cost Study of Two-year Education in South Carolina.

### PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS

The following permanent improvement requests were approved: (1) Replacement of Cooling Tower at Central Energy Facility, College of Charleston; (2) Installation of Fan Coil Units in South Campus Facility, South Carolina State College; (3) Expansion of Physical Facilities and Central Receiving Section, Trident Technical College; and (4) General Landscaping, Medical University of South Carolina.

### ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

The Commission granted approval to Clemson University and USC-Spartanburg to offer cooperatively their existing baccalaureate nursing programs on the campus of Greenville Technical College.

### 1983-84 ANNUAL REPORT

The Commission approved the 1983-84 Annual Report to the U.S. Department of Education on the South Carolina Higher Education Desegregation Plan.

### INFORMATIONAL REPORT

The Commission received as information a report on the provisions of the Education Improvement Act of 1984 which involve Commission responsibilities.
