Diabetes under the Dome is an annual event brought to the Legislators and State House Staff through the combined efforts of the **Diabetes Initiative of SC (DSC)** and the Medical University of South Carolina (MUSC). This is an annual special event that offers attendees the opportunity to receive an assessment of their diabetes or an assessment of their risk factors for developing diabetes.

The DSC, along with healthcare professionals from around the state, will assess the levels of participants' blood glucose, A1c, cholesterol, and blood pressure, and also measure weight & height to calculate BMI. Physician and diabetes education consulting services will be available free of charge.
