The State Budget Commission met in the Governor's office at 3:00 o'clock P.M. on February 6th, 1947. This was the first meeting of the Commission since the inauguration of newly elected State officers on January 21st, 1947. At this meeting the Commission was composed of Governor J. Strom Thurmond, Senator Edgar A. Brown, Chairman of the Senate Finance Committee, and Mr. Charles N. Flowden, Chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee.
