WHEREAS, citizens throughout the Palmetto State donate their valuable time, energy, and talents to making a difference in the lives of others through volunteerism; and

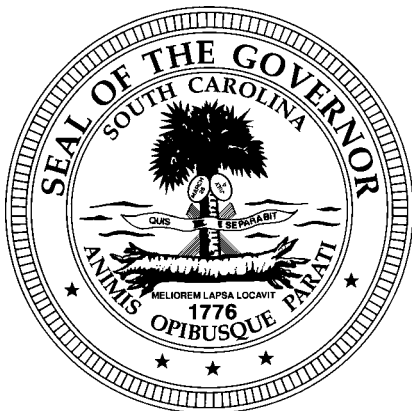
