### Monster Mash-up

Ages 5-7

10 am - noon

In this class, kids will experiment with a variety of materials to create beautiful, scary, zany, and absolutely wonderful creatures born from their imagination. Mixed media techniques include papier-mâché, painting, and collage. Course fee is \$85 plus \$25 for materials. Instructor – Brian Morgan.

### Medieval Adventures

Ages 8-10

Back by popular demand! In this printmaking camp, we'll experiment with gelatin plates and colors, shapes, and textures. Finding inspiration in paper cut-out collages by Henri Matisse, students will create their own collage-based prints. Course fee is \$85 plus \$30 for materials. Instructor – Katie Jones

### Fused Glass Artwork

Ages 10-14
