#### Description/Significant Features:

This resource is a small family cemetery measuring about 30x32 meters in size and situated in a moderately wooded pine/hardwood forest on a ridge side slope. A line of cedar trees is lines the eastern edge of the cemetery. There are approximately 16 burials. Fifteen are marked by fieldstones or depressions. Only one grave has marked stone, which is inscribed "In Memory of an Infant Child of W.H. and N.A. King Born March 17th and Died the 18th of 18?? Aged 24 Hours." The site boundary was drawn based on elements of the cemetery visible on the ground as well as the landform. The boundary was drawn to give the fieldstones and depressions a buffer of about 25 feet.
