

Columbia, South Carolina  
March 1, 1955

The State Budget and Control Board met in the Governor's office at 11:00 A. M., on March 1, 1955. All members of the Board were present.

Messrs. Louis Shimel, Henry Edmunds, William Ackerman and others appeared in the interest of purchasing 62.19 acres of marshlands in St. Andrews Parish, Charleston County, being a portion of the property known as South Windemere. The Board agreed to accept \$1,000.00 which was acceptable to Mr. Shimel, et al.

Senator E. B. Rodgers, Messrs. Dowling, Pollitzer, Elliott, and others appeared in the interest of obtaining an option to lease for six months lands in Beaufort County for mineral rights. The Board agreed to the option for the time named.

The Board agreed to sell to Mr. Sam Fox approximately 376 acres of marshlands at Edisto Beach, the consideration being \$1,500.00.

Mr. Greenberry Simmons, of Louisville, Kentucky, appeared in the interest of obtaining mineral rights on marshlands, tidelands, and underwater lands in Charleston County. The matter is being held in abeyance pending further negotiations.

The Board reconsidered a request from Clemson College for an allocation of \$20,000.00 from the Civil Contingent Fund to partly cover the cost of a survey of the Institution and agreed to the allocation.

The Board agreed to permit S. W. Gable, Acting Director of the South Carolina Development Board, to increase his salary payments from March 15 on this year so as to draw the entire amount appropriated for the position (\$8,500.00).

The Board then adjourned.
