WHEREAS, James L. Solomon, Jr., served as Executive Director of the South Carolina Higher Education Facilities Commission from 1973 until 1974; and

WHEREAS, from July 1, 1974, he served as the administrator of federal facilities programs and as Coordinator of Facilities on the staff of the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education; and

WHEREAS, in 1981 he was the chief architect of the State Higher Education Desegregation Plan and has administered, monitored, and evaluated the implementation of the Plan to the great satisfaction of State and federal authorities; and

WHEREAS, since July 1, 1982, he has served as Assistant Director for Facilities and Planning of the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education; and

WHEREAS, he has been appointed Commissioner of the South Carolina Department of Social Services, effective November 16, 1983;
