> TS Bonnie has been downgraded to TD Bonnie as of the 0800 update. All tropical storm warnings and watches have also been dropped along the coast. Bonnie's center is expected to move onshore this morning and continue northeast along the coast. No change in weather threats with rain still in the 2-4 inch range with possible winds as high as 35 mph. Primary concerns will be the possibility of isolated flooding and power outages.

> Jasper did report some localized flooding earlier this morning and currently there are less than 1000 power outages in throughout the state. There are no changes in county operational conditions and they remain at steady state.
