Katherine- I think this summary by SCANPO is a really good summary of what the bills do. If enacted by the legislature, the implementing bill would not become effective until 30 days after the constitutional amendment was ratified, so the earliest raffles would be legal would be 2015. That is still better than what we have now, which is incredibly uneven enforcement and total unawareness that all raffles, even for charitable purposes, are now illegal.
