I checked all visible network ports in the policy shop. Only one functional network connection is available, and that is one behind the Xerox 5755 copier. The new network printer, located where Madison Walker used to sit, could be located anywhere along the same wall as the Xerox 5755 copier. Moving that new network printer to the other wall by the Xerox copier would free up the network port where Madison Walker used to sit.

There are other unused network ports but they did not test as functional. We need to get DSIT to assist us with connecting those ports on the second floor of the Statehouse if we are going to use any of them. I do not know the cost but it would involve an hourly rate for two people as a minimum.
