A list of farm operations and roadside markets that have agritourism or agritainment activities is now available through the South Carolina Department of Agriculture.

Farmers are constantly looking for new ways to add value to their raw products and make their farms more profitable. At the same time, they feel a passionate need to communicate to city dwellers that they should take an interest in the origin of their food and in those who spend their lifetime producing it. A movement throughout the state and nation is underway to bring awareness to agriculture and, at the same time, provide an additional source of income for farm families. Agritourism” or “agritainment” is the idea of bringing visitors and tourists into rural and agricultural areas with farmers and their families benefiting from those dollars.

Several farmers in the state have added value to their operations by establishing corn mazes. The idea is to provide enjoyable and educational sources of good farming fun to communities around the state, and, at the same time, provide an additional source of income for farm families.

Others enjoy hayrides, farm tours, pumpkin carving, and other activities---activities that delight the young and the young at heart.

Commissioner’s Guest Column

Tougher Laws Set on Illegal Hunting

For this issue of the *Market Bulletin*, I have invited Dr. Paul Sandifer, Director of the South Carolina Department of Natural Resources, to write a guest column on a very important issue regarding hunting practices. Please be aware of laws regarding land use.

Hunting and fishing rights are additional sources of income for farmers and foresters, but please put safety first.

Poachers, trespassers and rogue hunters beware! DNR is cracking down on illegal hunting practices.

With an improved, stronger, tougher law on illegal road hunting, the South Carolina Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is cracking down on violators.

On July 18, 2001, Governor Jim Hodges signed a bill that strengthened the law prohibiting hunting on public roads or railroad rights-of-way, without permission to hunt the land immediately adjacent. The improved law is very clear and prohibits hunting from roads unless the hunter has permission to hunt adjacent land. This new law gives South Carolina conservation officers the ability to catch, charge and prosecute rogue hunters who have skirted the law and frustrated private landowners for years.

Without permission to hunt the land immediately adjacent to the road, individuals may not take deer or have in their possession or readily accessible in a vehicle any loaded center-fire rifle or shotgun loaded with a shot larger than No. 4.

DNR conservation officers have been enforcing the new law since South Carolina's earliest deer season began on August 15, 2001.

Unregulated road hunting has consistently been a hot issue in South Carolina. Because of the previously weak law and the fact that DNR officers had to actually see the poacher shoot at a deer, poachers took advantage of adjacent landowners, driving deer across their lands without fear of legal action. Often these poachers had the right to hunt on only a small piece of land in the area, yet they hunted the entire region.

Prior to the new law, it was difficult to prosecute poachers on public roads who were hunting local private lands under the guise of picking up dogs that had strayed off their property. Those excuses no longer work.

In addition to the improved illegal road hunting law, DNR is working with private landowners to catch and prosecute those that trespass to hunt or fish. The DNR Property Watch Program provides landowners with facts and information needed for a successful trespassing prosecution and the basic elements of property protection laws. In many cases, trespassing, unauthorized entry and property damages to merit a civil lawsuit are difficult to prove. Property Watch emphasizes trespass prevention and provides landowners with the information, knowledge and tools they need to avoid the problem before it arises. For more information on the Property Watch program contact your local DNR law enforcement office.

The public can help DNR conserve and protect South Carolina's wildlife and natural resources. Report fish and game violations, illegal hunters or trespassers by calling the Operation Game Thief hotline at 1-800-922-5431. All calls are confidential and rewards are offered for tips leading to an arrest.

SC Home to First Public Alternative Fuel Station in US

The nation’s first public alternative fuel refueling station, the first of its kind in the United States, officially opened its doors during a grand opening event in Aiken, SC, on October 18, 2001.

United Energy Distributors, Inc. (UED), will carry alternative fuels such as biodiesel and ethanol. Biodiesel is a fuel made from soybean oil that can be used in diesel engines without modification. The company is located off of Toolebeck Road in Aiken, and will have a refueling station for public use and the capability to deliver alternative fuels to any location in the state.

The refueling station will directly impact soybean farmers in South Carolina. Thanks to the soybean checkoff program,

research has shown that use of soy-based biodiesel in a conventional diesel engine results in substantial reduction of unburned hydrocarbons, carbon monoxide, and particulate matter compared to emissions from petroleum-based diesel fuel.

“We really want to get the word out about benefits of alternative fuels here in South Carolina,” said Red Roberts, president of UED.

Biodiesel can be used as a pure fuel or blended with petroleum in any percentage. B20 (a blend of 20 percent biodiesel with 80 percent petroleum diesel) has demonstrated significant environmental benefits with a minimum increase in cost for fleet operations and other consumers.

“The fact that we now have biodiesel available in South Carolina is a direct success of the soybean checkoff program,” said M. D. Floyd, president of the South Carolina Soybean Association and a soybean farmer from Scranton, S.C. “In these trying times, it is very important for us as a country to reduce our dependency on foreign oil.”
