### **Reminder: South Carolina Pork Board to Hold Annual Conference**

### **Master Programs to Be Offered**

The Pickens County Clemson Extension Office will be offering two Master programs. One will be the Master Tree Farmer Course and the other will be a Master Wildlifer Program.

A level II Master Tree Farmer Course will be held in February and March, 2002. The seven session course will be held on Tuesday evenings from 7-10 pm at Clemson University. Beginning February 5th, this workshop is designed for people who have completed the Master Tree Farmer Level One, or who have experience with forest management activities. The registration fee is \$80 per person or \$110 per couple.

Participants will receive a large notebook of reference materials, Master Tree Farmer cap and patch. After January 28th, there will be a late registration fee.

The Master Wildlifer shortcourse will be held for landowners and land managers in the upstate. Topics on wildlife management, wildlife damage control, food plots, and management for whitetail deer, wild turkey, and quail will be included in the sessions and will be offered to the first 25 people registered.

The program will be held at Clemson University on February 18th through March 4th, 2002 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. each Monday and Thursday night. There will also be a field trip/tour on Saturday, March 9th, from 8:30 a.m. until Noon.

A registration fee of \$50 per person includes refreshments, door prizes, one notebook, and other educational materials. The registration deadline is February 8th. The registration fee after February 8th is \$65 per person.

### **Keeping Your Poinsettia Happily Growing**

Meg Williamson, Clemson University Plant Problem Clinic diagnostician, tells how you keep your poinsettia happily growing.

- Remove decorative wrapping and place pot in a sunny window.
- Water thoroughly when the soil surface feels dry.
- When the bracts fade in March or April, cut the plant back to about 8 inches high. New growth will eventually emerge along the stem.
- Fertilize every 2 weeks during the growing season with a complete, well-balanced fertilizer, such as 10-10-10.
- Move the plant indoors, once night temperatures remain above 50 degrees. In early June, repot it into a container that is 2 to 4 inches larger than the original pot.
- Pinch back or prune to encourage branching, but refrain from pruning after September 1st if you want to force the plant to flower.

Meg says that forcing poinsettias to flower is possible, but rather difficult, for the home grower. She has advice for forcing poinsettias to flower.

- Poinsettias are short-day plants, which means to form blooms, long nights are needed for an 8 to 10 week period.
- The dark period of 14 hours must not be interrupted by light, but 6-8 hours of bright light is needed during the day.
- To accomplish this, the plant can be moved into a closet or covered with a box at night.
- Depending on the response time for the particular variety, flowering should occur during late November or December.

## ***Commissioner's Column***

### **SCDA Protects Consumers**

Remember the old saying, "If it's too good to be true . . .?" If something seems too good to be true, then it probably is.

The SC Department of Agriculture takes some of the burden off your shoulders in making sure that you're getting the most bang for your buck. Most people don't think much about whether the gallon of gas they pump actually equals a gallon or whether scales at the grocery store are accurate, but inspectors with the SC Department of Agriculture Consumer Services Division make those questions and others their business every work day.

The Consumer Services Division Metrology Laboratory is charged with ensuring that weights and measures devices throughout the state are accurate. Field specialists visit over 20,000 firms per year using highly accurate equipment to inspect the accuracy of all types of scales, gasoline dispensers, fuel oil meters, LP gas meters, and the net contents of packages to protect consumers, businesses, and manufacturers of this state. Also, these specialists collect official samples of gasoline, animal feeds, seeds, produce, and meats for analysis by the Department's Laboratory Division.

A successful weights and measures program requires a good working relationship with businesses, and the South Carolina Department of Agriculture commends the companies of our state for complying with the state's Weights and Measures Law.

While the Department is working to protect you and your family from fraudulent activities, there are some things that you can do to protect your interests. Whether you're buying from the grocery store, at your home, or through a publication like our own Market Bulletin, the key words are "Buyer Beware!"

As a note of caution to those who buy from the Market Bulletin---we accept ads in good faith and do not assume responsibility for ads published. But, there are things you can do to protect yourself. When purchasing an animal, you may want to have a pre-purchase agreement, a document signed by a licensed veterinarian stating that the animal has had the appropriate inoculations, worm testing, etc. and is in generally good condition. Also, be aware of the "bait and switch" tactic. If an ad says one thing and the product is another, let us know. For example, if a certain tractor model is advertised and you travel many miles only to find that the tractor is really another lesser model, we will investigate the matter. Or, if you know that an advertiser is really a commercial dealer, we would appreciate receiving a letter to that effect.

Another warning to consumers---be careful when buying meats door-to-door. Door-to-door meat sales involves someone coming to the door and offering meats at what seems like a reasonable cost. There are good, reputable companies in South Carolina who sell meat door-to-door, and there are those who deliver a high sales pitch to get consumers to buy by unit (box, case, or serving). Do not buy meat by unit! It's against the law!

Meat should be purchased by weight only and not by the serving, box, or case. Buying meats by unit does not tell you how much you are paying per pound. When you buy meat at your door, by law, you have a 3-day right to cancel. Simply notify the company in writing within three working days, if you want to cancel the sale. No reason for the cancellation is required. As long as you return the product you bought, the seller must refund your money.

To safeguard against suspect door-to-door sellers, always get references and several estimates and ask for the price per pound of any meat before you buy. Do not be misled by statements about the cost per serving or the cost per edible portion. Beware of any requests to accept delivery for a neighbor who wasn't at home and request an itemized receipt for your purchase. The receipt should show each type and the amount of meat purchased as well as the name, address, and telephone number of the seller.

Bargains are limited and anything better than a bargain is practically non-existent. So, buyer beware! The best way to avoid being fleeced is to protect yourself before you become a victim. If you think that you have been sold a bill of goods, immediately contact our Consumer Services Division at 803-737-9690. Or, if you have a question or comment about an ad or advertiser in the Market Bulletin, call 803-734-2536. The Department of Agriculture can not take action unless we know about it!
