CRP Incentives offered

Landowners can receive more money for participation in the Continuous Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) from the U.S. Department of Agriculture. The new financial incentives will total \$350 million over three years and include signing bonuses and more money for installing and maintaining conservation practices. Those practices include Field Windbreak, Grass Waterway, Filterstrip and Riparian Buffer. The bonus is equal to \$10 per acre times the number of years of the contract, which could range from 10 to 15 years. Land offered for CRP must have been rowcropped for two of the past five years, with the exception of marginal pastureland. For more information or specifics, call Linda Floyd at (803) 806-3857.

Cotton Referendum to be held soon

The Agriculture Commission of South Carolina will soon conduct a referendum by mail to S.C. cotton growers to continue the Marketing Order for the S.C. Cotton Board. The referendum will be conducted June 1-14. If the eligible voting producers vote not to continue the Marketing Order, it will be terminated. The Marketing Order provides a legal framework through which a Cotton Board could advertise and promote, research and market cotton products to achieve the declared policy of the Agricultural Commodities Marketing Act. A South Carolina Cotton Board composed of seven producer members and one ex-officio member will administer the Order. Copies of the Marketing Order may be obtained from D. of his income therefrom.

District 1 includes the Counties of Anderson, Cherokee, Greenville, Laurens, Oconee, Pickens, Spartanburg, and Union.
