Social Security has told us that you no longer receive a Supplemental Security Income (SSI) check. Your Medicaid benefits will stop too, unless you can be covered some other way. Your Medicaid will not stop immediately. We are letting you know so that you will have time to apply for another Medicaid program. You will receive a separate letter in the mail telling you when your Medicaid benefits will stop.

For Medicaid benefits to continue, you must complete an application form and provide verification of your income and resources, and those of your spouse if you are married.

Dear Senator Graham:

Thank you for contacting this agency on behalf of Mr. David Castleberry's Medicaid eligibility.

Mr. Castleberry's Medicaid coverage under the Supplemental Security Income (SSI) program will end effective September 1, 2013, because his income exceeds the allowable limit of \$710.00 monthly. Individuals who receive SSI are automatically eligible for Medicaid; however, when their SSI ends, their Medicaid must also end.

We have been in contact with Mr. Castleberry regarding our Aged, Blind or Disabled (ABD) program, and an application has been mailed to him to apply for this program. Ms. Carolyn Roach in our Office of Member Services will monitor the application, once he applies. If you have additional questions regarding the Medicaid Program, please contact Ms. Roach and she will be happy to assist you. Ms. Roach can be reached at (803) 898-3967.
