Ms Phelps,

It seems a snag in the reciprocity agreement strategy has developed. Sweden does not do reciprocal agreements. That said according to the attached document:

1. US licence is valid in Sweden for all persons on temporary stay in Sweden.
2. When a person moves temporarily to Sweden for education or work, the licence is valid for 1 yr from the date when registered as a habitant in Sweden.
3. This period can be extended by an application to the Swedish transport agency (Transportstyrelsen) for an additional 2 yrs. i.e. all in all 3 yrs.

And in reading 56-1-30(6) it seems this might be able to make this fit without a formal signing.

"....who is at least eighteen years of age, who is employed in South Carolina, and who has a valid driver's license issued by that jurisdiction may drive in this State for five years if the foreign jurisdiction provides a reciprocal arrangement for South Carolina residents." What do you think?  
Can we make this work?
