One of the FAQ's you provided (I'll list it below) seemed to address that but when I contacted my bank about closing my checking account and opening a new one they said that information was not compromised and they really did not want to do that. Since I'm getting so I don't know who to believe any more I'm hoping you can provide more information. Below is the FAQ that seemed to address the above.

***Q: What type of personal information may have been exposed?***

***A:*** While the investigation is still ongoing, South Carolina taxpayer's Social Security Numbers, debit card numbers, credit card numbers, and information that would be found on the front of a check like bank account and routing numbers may have been exposed
