3. Please include the date all aforementioned requests were received, and on what date the Office of the Governor initially responded to those requests.
4. Please indicate how the aforementioned records requests once completed were delivered (via CD, email, etc.)
5. A list of all fees requested by the Office of the Governor related to the aforementioned requests.
6. A list of all fees received by the Office of the Governor in connection to the aforementioned requests.
7. A list of the state government employees who have searched for, reviewed, or processed Freedom of Information Act requested records for the Office of the Governor during aforementioned time frame.
8. A list of government salaries for any state employees referenced above, if available.

As I am submitting this request in my capacity as a professional investigative reporter who has extensively covered Freedom of Information at the federal, state, and local levels, I ask that you waive all applicable fees associated with the search, review and duplication of any responsive records.
