A fisherman inadvertently caught a loggerhead while fishing at Myrtle Beach State Park, recently. If a member of the public accidentally catches a turtle while pier fishing remember:

*Don't cut the line!

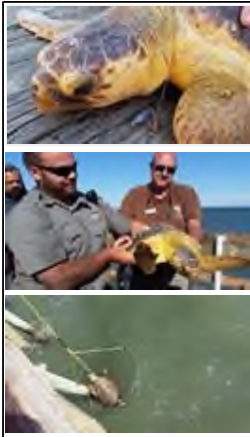
*Call the park staff at the fishing pier so they can come help.

*Try to gently bring the turtle close to the pier and bring it up with a drop net.

*If the turtle has a hook in the mouth, DO NOT cut the line close to the mouth- leave 2-3 feet of line in case it needs to be transported to the SC Sea Turtle Hospital in Charleston. Turtles have strong jaws and will bite- be careful!

*Keep the turtle shaded until help arrives.

Luckily, this turtle was caught & released with no injuries because these guidelines were followed!
