Size and cost estimates of the wildfire remain the same.

TODAY – Approximately **two inches of rain** have fallen on the fire and higher humidity levels have also helped slow the its progress. The rain also prevented crews from working so they were able to get some much needed rest.

OPERATIONS – Hopes are high that crews may begin demobilizing later this week as firefighting is expected to transition to a full-scale mop-up operation. No evacuations are anticipated and no additional structures are threatened.

SIZE – The fire is approximately 10,500 acres and is 62% contained.

COST – Estimated at \$4.5 million.
