Description/Significant Features:

The former commercial structure is a front-gabled concrete block building. It has a three-bay front elevation, which is beneath a gabled portico that is created by an extension of the main roofline, supported by round metal posts; the doorway is located on the northern bay, with two single-pane, plate-glass display windows to the south. There are no openings on the side elevations. The gable end is covered with aluminum siding and the roof has a standing-seam metal covering.
