

Chef Lee to Test and Develop Shad Recipes

Frank Lee, nationally known chef and partner at Slightly North of Broad Restaurant in Charleston, has agreed to test and develop shad recipes. If his research is successful in producing restaurant-quality, consumer-friendly recipes, Chef Lee could literally help feed the world by making shad a fish of choice for millions.

Charles Schuster, Food Inspector with the SC Department of Agriculture, said, "I am concerned that there will be no commercial fishing in South Carolina in the future if present trends continue." "Shad offers the greatest potential of all the seafood species harvested in the state," he added. Currently, the roe is consumed, but the rest of the fish is used mainly as crab bait.

SC Pecan Growers to Participate in Workshop

In a continuing effort to pool agricultural educational resources and research between neighboring states, the NC Pecan Growers Association (NCPGA) invites SC growers to participate in their 8th annual workshop on Saturday, March 23, 2002, at the Sampson County Agri-Exposition Center, 414 Warsaw Road, Clinton, NC.

Two South Carolina pecan growers, Tom Harmon of Gilbert and Joe Watson of Ridge Spring, are scheduled to serve as speakers in the daylong workshop.

In addition to the presentations by SC's own growers Watson and Harmon, Dr. Bill Ree, Extension Entomologist with Texas A & M University, will serve as guest speaker interacting with the growers throughout the day. Dr. Ree is nationally recognized as a leading entomologist focusing on pecan insect pests. His topic, "What's Bugging You," will be a broad overview of insect pests affecting pecan crops in the Carolinas. Also, Dr. Ree will draw attention to his reduced pesticide program by using Integrated Pesticide Management (IPM) strategies.

Commissioner’s Column

Agriculture Fuels the Economy

March is the point between winter when the earth sleeps and spring when everything seems to be reborn.

The first day of spring arrives every March when the earth is tilted just so the sun is directly over the equator. This event is called the vernal equinox. Vernal means spring, and equinox means equal night. On the first day of spring, night and day are the same length, each lasting exactly twelve hours.

National Ag Day occurs every spring just as naturally as the vernal equinox. Established by the Agriculture Council of America (ACA) in 1973, the event was developed as a way for all of us to say "thank you" to the hard working men and women who produce the raw products for our food, fiber, shelter, and, now, "fuel." Because of biodiesel and ethanol, we can add "fuel" to that lengthy list of ag products that farmers and their families provide for us.

Fuel is essential for farming. An effort is underway to increase fuel efficiency by raising corporate average fuel economy (CAFE) standards for cars and light trucks. A plan has been proposed to increase these standards for cars and light trucks to 35 miles per gallon for model year 2013 vehicles. The current fuel economy standard for light trucks is 20.7 miles per gallon and has been in effect since 1996. Increasing these standards could potentially reduce the availability and increase the cost of vehicles, particularly trucks.

Farming operations and farm-related companies depend on heavy pickups to perform daily towing and hauling tasks. An increase in the corporate average fuel economy standards would limit the range of vehicle choices for farmers as well as non-farmers. The National Academy of Sciences reported several years ago that raising these standards by 3 to 5 miles per gallon could increase the price of a full-size pickup truck by almost \$3,000. This could restrict access by farmers to modern, work-efficient trucks.

While some are looking at ways to decrease the use of fuel here at home, the nation's dependence on foreign oil must also be reduced. We can not depend on foreign countries for energy or anything else. We must use alternative fuels like ethanol and biodiesel fuel blends. We must improve the capacity to generate more electricity with other resources like wind and solar energy. But, a diverse array of energy resources like fossil fuels and nuclear, wind, and solar resources may not be enough. In order to reduce our dependence on foreign oil, energy can be produced from farm waste and plants grown specifically for producing energy.

In the fall of 2000, the USDA announced details for a \$300 million program to encourage expanded production of environmentally friendly fuels made from corn, soybeans, and other crops. At that time, the USDA solicited proposals for pilot projects that use harvested vegetation to produce energy.

In January of 2001, the USDA announced another \$30 million for investment in rural America. I provided this information to President James Barker and Dr. John Kelly of Clemson University and urged them to initiate an aggressive research program on alternative renewable energy sources that could be produced by South Carolina farmers. I also encouraged them to examine previous university research from the 70s experimenting with sweet potato varieties for biomass to produce liquid fuels. South Carolina ranks 9th in the nation in sweet potato production and seems to have just the right growing conditions for sweet potatoes. Other crops could possibly be grown in the state for production of fuel.

In the fall of 2001 just after the catastrophic events of September 11th, Dr. Calvin Schoulties, acting Dean of the College of Agriculture, Forestry and Life Sciences, wrote me saying that the department was in the process of developing a multi-region project on "The Science and Engineering for a Bio-Based Economy." In addition, he said that Clemson had received a \$170,000 energy grant award from USDA in the area of bio-based industries and was pursuing other USDA and Department of Energy grants for research in the area of bio-energy. In October of 2001, the first public biodiesel and ethanol refueling station, United Energy Distributors, Inc., opened in Aiken, SC. The use of renewable resources as sources of fuel is an alternative to fossil fuels and provides additional income for farmers. Farm production of renewable fuel resources not only adds value to farming operations but it also helps reduce the need for foreign fossil fuel.

Shad is a migratory fish species located in North America, Europe, and Asia. Shad are anadromous fish, swimming from the open sea up rivers to reach their spawning grounds. Like all anadromous fish, shad are born in fresh water, start to grow in fresh water, migrate to salt water for most of their lives, and return to fresh water after 3 to 6 years to mate. The shad migration begins along the North American Atlantic Coast in Georgia in January and concludes in Nova Scotia in July.

The problem with shad has been its 769 bones, strong taste, and oily content, so chefs and restaurateurs have avoided using the fish in their recipes. Once considered the "poor man's salmon," it has been said that shad prevented General Washington and his troops from starving during the winter of 1777-1778 at Valley Forge. A diverse fish, shad can be stuffed and baked or broiled or grilled. The shad roe can be cooked in a frying pan or broiled.

If Chef Lee successfully produces recipes using shad, the fish could prove to be a new source for commercial fishing operators in South Carolina and a new food product for chefs and restaurateurs throughout the state.
