WHEREAS, Americans will join together during 2013 to commemorate the 60th anniversary of the Korean War.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim July 15, 2013, as

throughout the state and encourage all South Carolinians to take time on this special day to recognize and honor our Korean War veterans and their families whose sacrifices have helped strengthen our nation and improve the quality of life of people around the world.
