

Dear Mr. Corn:

Thank you for your e-mail to the Honorable Mark Sanford regarding the appearance of misuse of Medicaid services. Abuse in any aspect of the Medicaid program is taken very seriously and will not be tolerated. If you or the pediatricians on whom you call would identify any Medicaid beneficiary who appears to be using Medicaid services inappropriately, Program Integrity staff will investigate and take necessary action up to and including removing the offending individual from Medicaid eligibility.

Since Medicaid is a joint state/federal program, there are federal guidelines regarding co-payments. These guidelines speak to whom co-payments are applicable as well as the amount of co-payment per service. Section 447.54 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) under "Maximum allowable charges" specifics the maximum cost-sharing amounts and the restrictions as to the utilization of co-payments.
