Statewide Summary – Steady progress continues with 24 more roads opened yesterday, and 9 more bridges. **SCDOT Maintenance Crews recovery efforts will persist with 7 day weeks and 12 hour shifts. 40 roads are under contract for repairs.**

SCDOT (construction group) and FHWA damage assessment teams continue to work to expedite contract repairs in accordance to FEMA requirements.

SC 51 and S-22-179 crossing at Black River in Georgetown County will be open before noon today.

Fifteen (15) counties have been assigned a SCDOT debris removal contractor. Five (5) counties have produced enough debris for activating operations for removal of construction and demolition debris. The counties where contractors are working are:
