Comments

This project replaces the S-43 bridge over Sawneys Creek. The Project Study Area (PSA), a 160 ft wide corridor, stretches for 1,200 ft along the road on either side of the bridge widening to 300 ft on either side of the bridge at the creek. The area of potential effect (APE) is the width of the PSA but confined to a length of 700 ft on either side of the bridge. A background review indicated no previously recorded cultural resources were within the project area. SCDOT records indicated the bridge to be replaced was historic but not eligible for the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP). A cultural resources survey conducted on 7/11/19 consisted of a pedestrian reconnaissance of the APE augmented by the excavation of shovel test pits (STP) at 30 meter intervals. A total of 27 STPs were excavated. Two potential STP locations were examined but not excavated because of ground disturbance. All STPs were negative. Four mid-20th century structures were identified (house-0094, outbuildings-0094.01–0094.02, and a well 0094.03). They were also recorded as archaeological site 38FA637. Site 38FA636, consisting of an earlier S-43 alignment and bridge remains, was also recorded. All are recommended not eligible for the NRHP. No additional cultural resources investigations are recommended.

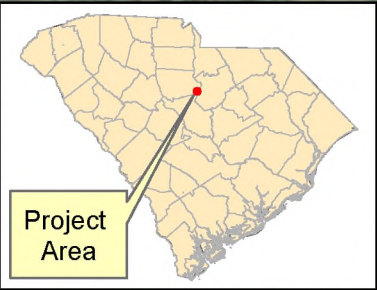
Effect Determination:

This screening form was developed to satisfy documentation requirements for Type I and Type II projects under a Programmatic Agreement between the Federal Highway Administration, the South Carolina State Historic Preservation Office, the US Army Corps of Engineers, and the South Carolina Department of Transportation. For Type I and Type II projects that have no effect on historic properties, the completion of this screening form with supporting documentation (e.g. ArchSite Map) provides evidence of FHWA and SCDOT's compliance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.
