I am hoping to develop a meeting to develop a best practice plan to develop a Flood water recovery plan in bringing our local hospitals back on line. While we can still care for patients in the hospital, our preflood sterilized instruments will be depleted by emergencies soon. It may take some time to get the water system back on line. I suggest that we coordinate a meeting to share solution ideas between hospitals and agencies. I think the Governor's office is an ideal coordinating body to get us started. My thoughts (not all inclusive) would include hospital representatives from all our local Hospitals, DHEC, DOT, legal, Infectious Disease, and anyone else interested. I have not been able to find a system that has already been outlined and this group could really help our systems locally as well as others who may experience these problems in the future.
