Mr. Poore called the meeting to order and Mr. Wiles gave the invocation.

On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Wiles, Council voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the August 9, 1979 meeting as mailed.

Mr. Jerry Rogers and other concerned citizens appeared before Council concerning Beaverdam Road. Mr. Rogers stated that the road was in terrible condition and needed to be repaved. Mr. Poore and Council agreed to let the County Engineer, Mr. Norman M. Walters, check out the road and repair by November 1, 1979 if possible.

Mr. Ray Turner, Chairman Loblolly Sewer Project, asked Council for approval of a referendum for Loblolly Pines Subdivision to become a special tax district. On the motion of Mr. Gerrard, seconded by Mr. Wright, Council voted unanimously to approve a referendum for Loblolly Pines Subdivision.

Mr. Dave Watson discussed the need for a new boiler in the Agriculture Building. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted unanimously to send out bids for a new boiler capable of burning either oil or natural gas. Then to report back to Council all results for a final decision.

Mr. James Adams presented to County Council a tax bill on property that he said he did not own. Mr. Poore stated that Mr. Adams should see the Tax Assessor or Auditor and discuss his problem with them. Mr. Robert Lusk, County Attorney, has a copy of the tax notice and intends to look into the matter.

On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Wiles, Council voted unanimously to adjourn at 10:02 a.m.
