Pageland hosts 48th Watermelon Festival

In the tradition of celebrating South Carolina’s fruits and vegetables during the summer months, the 48th annual Pageland Watermelon Festival will begin on Friday, July 23. Here’s a brief look at some of the weekend’s highlights:

The festival, which will be held through Sunday, July 25, will have dozens of events and activities both in downtown Pageland and at the Pageland Farmer’s Market.

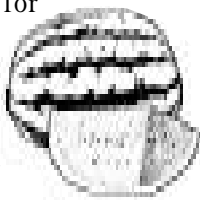
On Saturday will be the traditional watermelon seed-spitting and eating contests, but this year’s festival has even more to offer.

On Friday the helicopter rides begin at the farmers market, as well as the amusement and pony rides for those who prefer to stay closer to the ground. The Melon Tours of History will begin at 9 a.m. Friday morning. Melon Magic, a rodeo, and the Pageland Watermelon Queen Pageant are also scheduled for Friday. That evening, the day’s events will end in style with music by The Tams, The Breeze Band and Too Much Sylvia.

Saturday’s fun begins at 10:30 a.m. The Melon Relay Race and Watermelon Parade start the day off, with more events throughout the day and more music that evening.

International gourmet and craft displays will be at the Farmer’s Market on Saturday and Sunday, and more than \$1000 cash will be given away on both days. More entertainment, including a lawn tractor race and more live music, are scheduled for Sunday.

The Pageland Farmer’s Market is located on U.S. 601 about two miles north of Pageland, near the North/South Carolina state line. Tickets for the Friday and Saturday night concerts are available at Moore’s and Belk stores across the state. For more information, call (843) 672-5257.

Commissioner’s Column

Plant & flower fests increase sales

Does 90,000 customers in three weekends sound like a good turnout for an ornamental horticulture business? Just ask our vendors at this year’s plant and flower festivals.

The plant and flower festivals held in April this year were a huge success, with a total of more than 90,000 customers combined. But successes always come with obstacles, and the obstacle facing plant growers next year will be producing enough plants and flowers to meet an ever-increasing demand.

The S.C. Department of Agriculture coordinates the festivals at our State Farmers Markets in Columbia, Florence and Greenville, and I sincerely appreciate the efforts of department employees and plant vendors who make these festivals successful. Their work, combined with the support of shoppers who attend the festivals, have made the events so popular that next year we’re adding another city — Charleston — to our festival line-up. The exact location of the new festival will be announced later.

The Florence festival at the Pee Dee State Farmers Market is both the oldest and largest of all three festivals. But they are all growing, and this year, overwhelmed by demand, many vendors found they would have sold even more if only they had grown more plants in preparation for the four-day events.

Because of this demand for many plant varieties in 1999, I’m urging growers to plan ahead for next year. With a booming economy, the average household has more disposable income. That’s good news for nursery owners, because many households are willing to spend more money on their lawns and gardens than they have in the past. And our plant and flower festivals provide the best opportunities for consumers to find exactly what they want.

The flower shows are successful for many reasons. One is they give consumers one of the largest venues available for finding plants, flowers and garden accessories. Because of the important economic impact they have on plant and flower businesses in the state, I am pleased to see each show continue to grow.

The Pee Dee Plant and Flower Festival in Florence, the oldest of the three shows, had the largest turn-out this year. Bad weather resulted in a slow first day of the show, but with the sun came the shoppers, and more than 51,000 people attended the festival, much to the satisfaction of our vendors. How does a flower festival draw so many? The most common answer I hear each year is variety. There were more than 70 vendors at the Florence festival, which means folks could find a selection of plants there they can’t find anywhere else. The Pee Dee State Farmers Market also has a fall plant and flower festival, which will be held on Oct. 1-3 this year.

Another advantage to buying your plants at the festivals is you can get information on how to care for what you buy straight from the grower. Who knows more about the plants you want to raise than someone who has grown them for years?

The Greenville and Columbia festivals are still young, so they have the potential to grow exponentially in the coming years. More than 20,000 people and 30 vendors attended the Columbia festival and more than 15,000 people and 20 vendors attended the Greenville festival.

Many vendors rely on the festivals for a hefty percentage of their yearly profits, and oftentimes people who buy products from them at the festivals become repeat customers. It’s a win-win situation for everyone. Dick Felder, who coordinates the festival, can be reached at (803) 734-2210 if you have any questions about next year’s festivals.

I urge all growers to be prepared for spring of 2000. With four festivals, there will be an even higher demand for plants and flowers than this year. Additionally, if on-site sales increase, so does the potential for getting repeat customers. I’m looking forward to the continued growth of our ornamental horticulture and floriculture industries, and we at the Department of Agriculture will continue to do our part to promote both.
