Governor,

Your last Executive Order for regulation relief for the Colonial Pipeline issue is set to expire at midnight tonight for Hours of Service and on the 19<sup>th</sup> for the Weight/Size. These deadlines are set by statute.

We asked Dukes Scott to get feedback from industry marketers and suppliers on their continued needs, and they report that **business should return to normal activity on October 10<sup>th</sup>**—while there are no outages in SC, they are still trying to fill backlogged orders. Our office has also received requests independently from industry folks to extend the waivers. (Note that NC has waivers in place to expire in mid-October as well.)

**We recommend that you issue another Executive Order to extend the HOS waiver so that it and the Weight/Size waivers will expire on October 10<sup>th</sup>.** Please let us know your decision.
