
Your correspondence dated February 18, 2015 to Governor Haley, Senator Graham, Senator Scott, and Congressman Mulvaney has been forwarded to my office for review and response. I understand you are requesting a Post Office on Highway 521 in Indian Land, SC.

I appreciate your interest in assisting Indian Land customers with a request for a new Post Office. Although community growth can result in a need for additional or expanded Postal facilities, it is not a sufficient cause—by itself—to establish an independent Post Office. The Postal Service is a self-supporting agency that funds its operations from the revenue generated by the sales of our products and services—not through taxpayer subsidies. Like a commercial business, we are subject to economic factors that drive up costs or adversely impact revenue such as new construction or rental expenditures.

There are currently no plans to build a new Postal facility in Indian Land. There are four Post Offices within a 15 minute driving time from Indian Land. Fort Mill Post Office, which services the Indian Land area, is located at 201 Tom Hall Street. There is also a Contract Postal Unit in Indian Land; the M J Mart is located at 9775 Charlotte Highway. Additional nearby facilities include the Catawba Post Office at 4795 Cureton Ferry Road, Van Wyck Post Office at 5222 Old Hickory Road, and Waxhaw Post Office at 100 Waxhaw Parkway. You may be assured that we will continue to monitor service to our Indian Land customers to ensure their Postal needs are adequately met.

I hope this information is helpful in giving you further mailing options.
