Code Commissioner


Mr. F. M. Easterlin, president, and a large delegation from the South Carolina Old Age Pension Association, appeared before the Commission and urged that provision be made for greater benefits to the old aged.

The following transfers were approved by the Commission:

From State Medical College - Maintenance Summer School	\$15,000.00 to	Comptroller General's Office - Election Expense
From State Medical College - Maintenance Summer School	1,000.00 to	State Board of Health Bureau of Vital Statistics - Temporary Help
From State Medical College - Maintenance Summer School	1,000.00 to	State Supt. of Education Expense of Committee to Investigate Recertification of Teachers

The Commission then recessed until 4 P. M., and at that time met and discussed the various budgets as presented by the departments and institutions, with the view of formulating its recommendations thereon.

The Commission then adjourned.
