Vocabulary


Funnel cloud: A cloud that forms a tornado and spins in a spiral

Vortex: A whirling massive body of air


Doppler Radar: A radar tracking system that measures how fast the wind is traveling

Safety Precautions

There are over 100 deaths each year from tornadoes.

5. Stay away from automobiles

Daulatpur-Salturia Tornado

This tornado occurred on April 26, 1989, in Bangladesh.

1. This tornado was over one mile wide.
2. It traveled 50 miles from Bangladesh to Saturaia.
3. The tornado caused 5.2 billion dollars of damage.
4. It killed over one thousand people, injured over 8,000 people, and left thousands of people homeless.



Tornado Alley

1. Over one thousand tornadoes strike tornado alley each year.
2. On average 158 people die from tornadoes each year in tornado alley.
3. Tornado alley is made up of four states; Texas, Nebraska, Kansas, and Oklahoma.
4. Most of the tornadoes occur from 3:00-9:00pm
5. The longest tornado lasted for 3 hours and traveled all the way through tornado alley.
