As discussed in the meeting, I have attached the updated language for the appointment of the Superintendent of Education (approved by Superintendent Spearman). The new timeline pushes the appointment past 2018 and allows ratification and enabling legislation for Superintendent qualifications to occur in 2017-2018.
