Dies Suddenly

At Home in City

Funeral services for George Trezvant Coleman, 64, writer, suddenly early yesterday died of heart disease at his home here, Gonzales Gardens, will be conducted this morning at 11 o'clock.

Mr. Coleman, a son of the late county sheriff and City Postmaster W. H. Coleman and Mrs. Ann Coleman, and a brother of the late Columbia Mayor William Coleman, was an employe of the Hotel Wade Hampton.

Final rites will be conducted by the Rev. Lewis N. Taylor, rector of the Episcopal Church of the Good Shepherd, at McCormick's mortuary, with interment at Elmwood cemetery.

He is survived by his widow, the former Annette Beech; four sisters, Miss Myrtle Coleman and Mrs. J. B. Sylvan, Sr., of Columbia, Mrs. J. A. Krentzlin of Washington and Mrs. F. F. Hough of Richmond, Va.; and several nieces and nephews.
