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**Subject:** Breakthrough for Foster Care data management

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Hello,

The [Network of Care for Foster Care](#) consolidates all public and private services in the county into an easy-to-use search engine. It then provides key information to the foster child and his foster family, such as programs and services for foster parenting, transition-age youth, ADHD, adoption services, weight/fitness, diabetes management and more.

Even more important is the Foster Health Link – a Personal Health Record provided for each foster child. Here, we have created a way to store all important personal information from multiple agencies for each child in a fully secure record that the county can choose to share with a caregiver, foster parent or other county personnel. The result is a way to share critical information among all those involved with the care of a foster child.
