Governor, Haley:

My condolences to the citizens of South Carolina for the recent tragedy with the nine lives lost during the massacre in Charleston.

However, with the press conference that the President has made I need to feel that I need to position on this tragedy.

South Carolina has churches and places of worship under South Carolina Code Section 23-2-1(M) for concealed firearm permit holders. Basically your State legislature created the venue this type of tragedy could occur by taking away their right to self defense. Predators such as perpetrator of this incident pick the easiest targets. A church being a prohibited under South Carolina law was a catalyst to this tragedy, He knew everyone was unarmed.

I will be traveling through your State next month to help my significant other move from up to Jacksonville, Florida. We will be fueling up in North Carolina who honors a significant part of my licenses and permits to carry and driving through your State nonstop. Prior to entering your State I will be changing from my lawful concealed carry mode to the modes allowed for vehicle travel under South Carolina Code Section 16-23-20 or under the Federal Firearm Owners Protection Act.

also known as 18 USC § 926A.

We will be avoiding stopping in your State. Until South Carolina will honor my licenses and I have a non-resident Florida concealed weapon and firearm permit, but it's not honored because I'm not a resident of Florida. Nevada also honors South Carolina concealed weapon permits but they won't honor my Nevada.

I'm a firearm and concealed weapons instructor since 2005. When South Carolina honors my carry, I will spend money in your State, until then, we're going to pass through via the least restrictive peaceable journey laws either by the your State or the United States.

I even called your office, talked to a state ombudsman about getting him some long term placement so he can get the help he needs to have a productive life. Apparently the laws in this particular state is that until he hurts himself or someone else I cannot get him hospitalized. His meds don't work. I can't get his psychiatrist at the mental health clinic to change them and I have mounds of paperwork to prove that his acute hospital stays in 8 months did not help among various other things. The Charleston shooting was more than likely due to a mental illness. The parents are criticized and the public wants help including you. I didn't realize the death penalty was a mental health facility for this man to go to help he should have already gotten. According to the law in this state I have to wait for my son to hurt and hurt others before I can get him any help with his mental illness. Isn't it a shame he might seriously injure or kill someone before people will see. When they see they will want his life and judge me for my parenting. You made the law this way so why are these children/young adults paying the ultimate price along with innocent victims when the law states in order to get long term placement for help they must hurt someone or themselves. Is the public aware of the law you support. The law needs changed. My son might be the next kid you see on t.v. and then you'll

one to blame but yourself. I thought your campaign was for children like this so where were you before hand? You need to be more proactive its easier than cleaning up a horrible mess and blaming others for your shortcomings.

Dear Governor Haley,

All of us share your grief at the killing of nine Black People. Hate crimes like this are happening too often and everyone has a responsibility to look into their hearts to find what we all must stop all of these senseless kills -- especially hate crimes. I never stop grieving when I hear of more senseless killings in our country.

One thing your state can do is to take down the confederate flag. The following article by R Gross contains the sentiments of many Americans who are mourning:

If you're the governor of a state that suffers a tragedy, the common sign of respect is to fly a state's flags at half-staff. It's what Connecticut Gov. Dannel Malloy did in 2013, after the Sa Hook Elementary School massacre. It's what Colorado Gov. John Hickenlooper did in 2012 after the Aurora movie theater shooting. It's also what South Carolina Gov. Nikki Haley did today, after a white man in Charleston, South Carolina, allegedly shot and killed nine people at a historic church in an act that is already being investigated by the FBI as a hate crime.

Lowering the flag is a widely recognized gesture, a way to honor the dead as the state and country mourn. In South Carolina, however, one flag is a potent symbol of racism--and a symbol cl

the alleged gunman himself in the form of a decorative plate on his car. So why is the Confed flag, which flies over the grounds of South Carolina's Capitol Complex, still waving in the breeze at its peak height?

To understand what seems like a shockingly callous move, first you have to understand what the battle flag is doing there at all. (After all, it's not South Carolina's state flag, the palmetto flag, which features a rather beautiful tree and crescent design.) The Confederate flag used to fly proudly over the State House dome itself, ever since the state's then-all-white legislature voted that it be so as a symbol of defiance against the Civil Rights movement. It would take nearly 40 years, a battle by the NAACP that reportedly cost the state more than \$7 billion, massive protests, and the condemnation of presidential nominee John McCain for the Legislature to reconsider flying the flag on the building that represents their state government.

Finally, in 2000, the state passed a bill banning the Confederate flag from being flown over the State House dome as well as in the chambers of the Senate and House of Representatives. It was in the south side of the Confederate Soldier Monument, where it stands now. Along with the move came a new statute. "This flag must be flown on a flagpole located at a point on the south side of the Confederate Soldier Monument, centered on the monument, ten feet from the base of the monument at a height of thirty feet," it reads.

What that means is that in South Carolina, the Confederate flag abides by its own rules. While other governors—as well as the president—can usually order that all state and national flags within their jurisdiction be flown at half-staff, this one is exempt. Instead, the Confederate flag's location can be changed only by a two-thirds vote by both branches of the General Assembly. "In South Carolina, the governor does not have legal authority to alter the flag," said a press secretary for Haley. "Only the General Assembly can do that." That is why, while other flags under the authority of the governor have all been lowered in mourning, this one is still flying so audaciously. Even if Haley could order it lowered, it's not clear that she would; in the past, she's actually defended keeping the flag on the grounds, reassuring voters that it's done nothing to harm the state's image.

Since the General Assembly ended its 2015 legislative session on June 5, it's likely the Confederate flag will continue to fly high, while the families of the shooter's nine black victims mourn the carnage of this hate crime.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. It would be a great first step.

Nitrogen is the most sophisticated & preferred method of death by those committing suicide. It is odorless, tasteless, and simply presents a brief euphoria prior to the loss of consciousness, brain death occurs within seconds of that organ being deprived of oxygen.

South Carolina Governor Gets Called Out For Cowardly Confederate Flag Defense

One viral Facebook comment perfectly summed up the outrage many are feeling.

Following the tragic mass killing in Charleston, one figure many have turned to for leadership state's Republican governor, Nikki Haley. She has not provided that leadership.

Her initial comment on the shooting eluded the racism explanation altogether, leading one of constituents to condemn her remarks in a Facebook post that went viral:

This morning, Haley appeared on CBS Morning News and was asked if it is finally time for tl to stop adorning government buildings with the Confederate Flag. Haley dodged the question, refusing to give her personal opinion, and seemed to imply that a debate over the flag would b traumatizing for her state:

HOST: There are also calls today that you have to take the Confederate flag down from the st: capitol. How do you address those calls?

HALEY: I think that...at a time like this, you have to look back at what we've done. Fifteen years ago, at the General Assembly at the time they had a conversation. The Republicans and Democrats and everybody came together on a consensus to bring the Confederate flag down off of the dome and they put it on a monument out in front. I think that conversation will probably come back up again. And you know what we hope that we do things the way South Carolinians do. Which is have the conversation, allow some thoughtful words to be exchanged, be kind about it. Come together and talk about what we're trying to achieve and how we're trying to do it. I think the state will start talking about that again. We'll see where it goes. What I will tell you right now, is while a lot of issues will come up, my job as governor is to bring everybody back together again. [...]

HOST: But what's your position on the issue?

HALEY: You know, right now, to start having policy conversations with the people of South Carolina, I understand that's what you'll want, my job is to heal the people of this state. We have a 17-year-old that just graduated college. We had anywhere from a 26-year-old to an 87-year-old grandmother. You had a track coach. You had a librarian. This is very real to us. [...] There will be policy discussions and you will hear my voice come out and talk about it. But right now, I'm not doing that to the people of my state.

Haley did however appear to be willing to make one policy decision – calling on the suspect in the shooting to be executed.

The governor's lack of leadership is in stark contrast to one state west – Georgia. There, Gov. Zell Miller (D) in 1992 called for changing the Georgia flag so it no longer reflected the Confederate battle symbol. “The Georgia flag is a last remaining vestige of days that are not only gone but also shameful days that we have no right to be proud of,” he said at the time. “We need to lay the days of segregation to rest, to let bygones be bygones and rest our souls. We need to do what is right.” Although the flag was not changed until 2001, Miller's call 23 years ago shows that a governor even in a deep south state can lead on the issue if they choose to.

Haley's avoidance of the issue of racism altogether eludes the elephant in the room. Compare her words to those of the Reverend Martin Luther King, Jr., who spoke after the 1963 Birmingham church bombing:

And yet they died nobly. They are the martyred heroines of a holy crusade for freedom and human dignity. And so this afternoon in a real sense they have something to say to each of us in their death. They have something to say to every minister of the gospel who has remained silent behind the security of stained-glass windows. They have something to say to every politician [Audience: Yeah] who has fed his constituents with the stale bread of hatred and the spoiled meat of racism. They have something to say to a federal government that has compromised with the undemocratic practices of southern Dixiecrats (Yeah) and the blatant hypocrisy of right-wing northern Republicans. (Speak) They have something to say to every Negro (Yeah) who has passively accepted the evil system of segregation and who has stood on the sidelines in a mighty struggle for justice. They say to each of us, black and white alike, that we must substitute courage for caution. They say to us that we must be concerned not merely about who murdered them, but about the system, the way of life, the philosophy which produced the murderers. Their death says to us that we must work passionately and unrelentingly for the realization of the American dream.

What Haley does not seem to be conceding is that to heal, you must first admit to your problem. Failing to address the legacy of racism in South Carolina will only conceal a wound, not ameliorate it.

Dear Governor Haley,

I was devastated to learn of last night's events in Charleston, as I know you were, too. I saw that you wrote that you can't comprehend what could motivate an attack like this (or something to that effect). To me, it is not difficult to imagine what motivated this tragedy - racism. There are 19 known hate groups operating freely within South Carolina, as is their right to do, but I wish that our state was not such a hospitable site for bigots.

History tells us that South Carolina, and Charleston in particular, has long been a center of racial tensions. In recent months, with the shooting of Michael Brown, these tensions have only grown. While the Confederate flag represents an important period in South Carolina's history and struggle for states' rights in the Civil War, it only gained public popularity in the 20th century as a symbol of the segregationist movement, which opposed civil rights. The historical importance of the site of the 1831 shooting, where Denmark Vesey led a slave revolt, must not be overlooked, either. We cannot divorce this shooting from the deeply rooted cultural and historical context in which it occurred. Why are we still flying the confederate flag? To me, this is no different from Germans flying the Nazi flag because of "history," which they certainly would not do.

Last week, there was controversy over the Confederate flag being depicted on the cover of the

Charleston City Paper, and today, that flag still flies on the State House grounds in Columbia as the United States and South Carolina flags fly at half mast, in honor of this devastating tragedy. I urge you, as a born and raised South Carolinian, to please make the decision to finally remove the Confederate flag from the state house grounds. We need to send the message to the rest of the country that SC will not stand for racial violence and that we are not okay with what occurred that night.

I recall your comments from 2014 about having talked with many CEOs who never mentioned having a problem with the Confederate flag, and I wonder if any CEOs have contacted you since then. I disagree. I graduated from College of Charleston in 2013, where I was a recipient of the Palmetto Fellows Scholarship and the CofC Presidential Scholarship for all four years, with a degree in Computer Science. I now live in San Francisco and work in its booming tech industry, and I look forward to the day that I will speak with you as a CEO. South Carolina has been good to me, providing me with a free education. I would like to be able to return the favor via tax dollars, but I cannot live in a state that still defends such a hateful symbol of white supremacy. Many of my brilliant friends and classmates have also left and given up on the state because of its antiquated and bigoted culture. If the moral argument to end racial violence and intolerance is not compelling enough, please consider the practical financial argument - racism is costing SC money, period. Please take a stand and take down the flag, once and for all.
