Christian--

Mr. Magill asked that I let you know of the arrest of a DMH employee late Wednesday. A DMH employee in Columbia who works as an Information Technology specialist, David Robinson, has been charged with Criminal Solicitation of a Minor.

The charges do not relate to a DMH patient; rather, DMH was contacted by a Detective in Florida who, while posing on the Internet as a 14 year old girl, was allegedly propositioned by the Robinson. The Detective traced the IP address back to an address at DMH.

Based primarily on the evidence provided by law enforcement in Florida, and in consultation with SLED and the SC Attorney General's Office, DMH Public Safety arrested Robinson. The employee has been suspended pending investigation, and his DMH computer has been secured pending examination by SLED.
