The Department proposes to use consultant engineering diving services to perform underwater bridge inspections in various counties in District 2, 3, and 4.

This will enable the Department to remain in compliance with FHWA and AASHTO regulations which require that bridges which meet certain criteria receive underwater inspections on a regular cycle not to exceed five years. It is recommended that the Commission approve the entering into this contract by the Department.

The estimated cost for performing this work is \$260,000.

Agreement with Retail Projects of South Carolina to provide improvements to S. C. Route 12 (Forest Drive) and S. C. Route 16 (Beltline Boulevard) in the vicinity of Richland Mall in Richland County

The Department requests Commission approval to enter into joint funding agreement with Retail Projects of South Carolina to provide for construction improvements along Forest Drive and Beltline Boulevard in the Vicinity of Richland Mall.

This project will provide for intersection improvements and additional traffic lanes at and along Forest Drive and Beltline Boulevard to provide improved access and traffic flow to the proposed Regional Mall Shopping Center.

Funding for this project will be State Primary/Urban and is estimated to cost approximately \$500,000.00. The Developer will provide 75% of this cost and the Department will provide 25%.

AGREEMENT WITH BUDGET & CONTROL BOARD, HUMAN RESOURCE MANAGEMENT DIVISION, STAFF
DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING UNIT

At the September 17, 1987 meeting of the Commission, the Department was given authorization to revise its public transportation program of projects and enter into agreement with the Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA). The authorization allowed for implementing the UMTA/Section 18-Rural Transit Assistance Program (RTAP) which is 100% federally funded (\$86,013). South Carolina's program emphasis is aimed at providing training opportunities to/for rural and small urban public transportation operations so as to increase their overall effectiveness.

It is recommended that the Commission authorize the Department to enter into a letter of agreement with the Budget & Control Board's Human Resource Management (HRM) Division in an amount not to exceed \$67,548. HRM would provide the Department's Public Transportation Division (PTD) logistical assistance and be responsible for workshop facility arrangements, registration of participants, lodging and meals. The assistance would result in the establishment and conduct of 4 major transit workshops for transit managers, other professionals and governing boards of 75 transportation operations involving approximately 280 people. (Item # PT-044)

Recommendation 9/22/88

AGREEMENT WITH ATE MANAGEMENT AND SERVICE COMPANY, INC.

At the June 16, 1988 meeting of the Commission, the Department was given authorization for the expenditure of Urban Mass Transportation Administration Section 18/Rural Transit Assistance Program (RTAP) funds (\$81,403). The program is 100% federally funded.

Upon the Commission's approval, a bid solicitation, review, and selection process was conducted through the Department's Purchasing Division to secure consultant services for developing and implementing training curricula for rural and small urban managers, other professionals and governing boards of South Carolina transportation operations. The Purchasing Division has concluded that ATE Management and Service Company, Inc. submitted the most responsive proposal.

It is recommended that the Commission authorize the Department to enter into an agreement with the ATE Management and Service Company, Inc. to develop and implement the RTAP training curricula for four comprehensive transit workshops. The total contract maximum is recommended to be \$24,978.

AGREEMENT WITH BURTON & ASSOCIATES, INC.

At the June 19, 1986 meeting of the Commission, the Department was given authorization in its public transportation program of projects to conduct a study to evaluate insurance needs of public transportation operators. The authorization allowed for the expenditure of Urban Mass transportation Administration Section 8 funds (\$25,448) and State General funds (\$6,362) to be used for this purpose.

With this approval, a bid solicitation, review and selection process was conducted through the Department's Purchasing Division to secure consultant services for the conduct of a comprehensive insurance study of public transportation operators in the State. The Purchasing Division has concluded that Burton and Associates, Inc. submitted the most responsive proposal.

It is recommended that the Commission authorize the Department to enter into an agreement with Burton and Associates, Inc. to conduct the comprehensive Statewide public transportation insurance study in a contract maximum not to exceed \$28,516. Furthermore, the 20% local match (\$5,703) for the 80% UMTA Section 8 federal funding (\$22,813) is recommended to be re-allocated from State Highway Funds rather than State General Funds due to the current funding level of the Department's Public Transportation Division's current State allocation. This is not a request for additional State Highway funds. (Item # PT-046)

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ALLOCATION REVISION - 1988-89 STATE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM
AND STATE STRATEGIC HIGHWAY PROGRAM

In June 1988, the Commission allocated \$10,000,000 for the State Economic Development Program and \$43,002,000 for the State Strategic Highway Program.

Under the provisions of Section 1 of Act 197 of 1987, annual replenish of the Economic Development Account must be made from funds generated by the tax levied in Section 12-27-1210 of the 1976 Code. The total in the account at no time may exceed fifteen million dollars.

The actual balance in the fund as of June 30, 1988 amounted to \$9,715,841.51; while the amount necessary to replenish the fund is \$5,284,158.49, detailed below:
