Description/Significant Features: Road 1306.02 (Goldings Road South) is the southern portion of a historic route leading from Bacon's Bridge Road south approximately 1.30 miles from the northern tract boundary to Line Road (Road 1306), in the central portion of the project tract. Road 1306.02 averages 20 ft wide and 25-35 ft amsl elevation and its surface is an aggregate of dirt and gravel. Most of the roadbed lies at ground level except where it crosses through wetlands. In wetlands the roadbed is raised two to three ft above ground surface.

**Historical Information**

Historical Information: In addition to Line Road (Road 1306), Roads 1306.01-1306.04 comprise the remainder of the five roads on the project tract attributed to the plantation era (ca. 1675-1865).

Baluha and Owens (2017) documented the northern portion of Goldings Road (Road 1174.00), which ends at a plowed field in Goldings Plantation north of the project tract. Road 1174.00, the unrecorded central portion of the road, and Road 1306.02 no longer connect because the roadway has been bisected by the plowed field and a ditch and embankment that parallels the boundary between Goldings Plantation and the project tract. Road 1306.02 intersects Wampee Road (Road 1306.01) at the Burbage Hunt Club (Resource 1326), which is also the former location of the Wampee Plantation settlement (Site 38DR254). Historic aerials and quadrangles show Road 1306.02 (USGS 1920, 1944, 1957, 1959, 1961, 1973). During the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries, this road provided direct access for plantations on Jack Savannah from Bacon's Bridge Road.
