Hi Amy, I hope you are doing well and fully recovered from a successful Heritage Tournament. It was good to see you.

We have an annual event on Hilton Head called the Rib Burnoff and Barbecue Fest which I started in 1997 and it's in the 18th year. It is a charity event put on by my club, The Kiwanis Club of Hilton Head Island, attracts a crowd of 1,000-1,500 and raises \$20,000 for various children's charities like Boys and Girls Club, Marine Corps Scholarship Fund, Toys For Tots, etc. We have typically 20 cooks: 2/3 restaurants and 1/3 amateurs. Awards are given out in the blind judging category for which we have a panel of 10 judges led by 4 SC BBQ Assn certified judges and local celebrities and politicians ☺. We also have awards for the Popular Vote which are determined by the ticket holders, blah blah blah.
