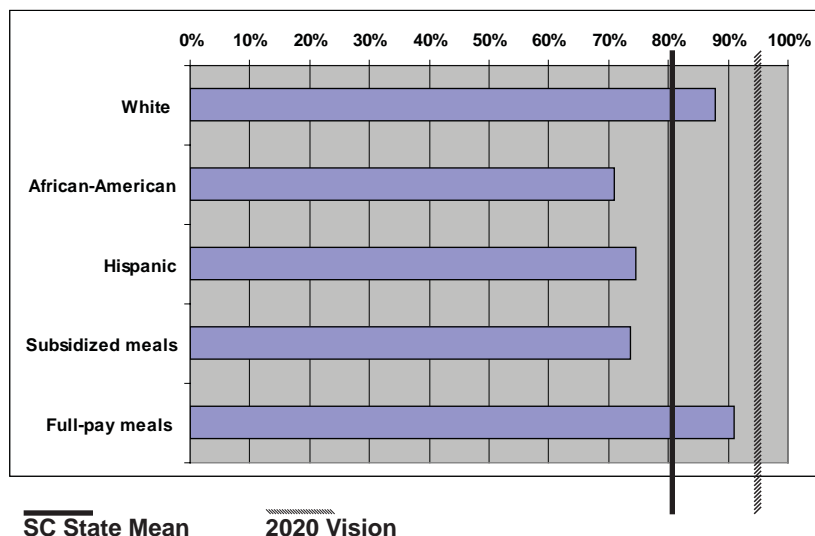

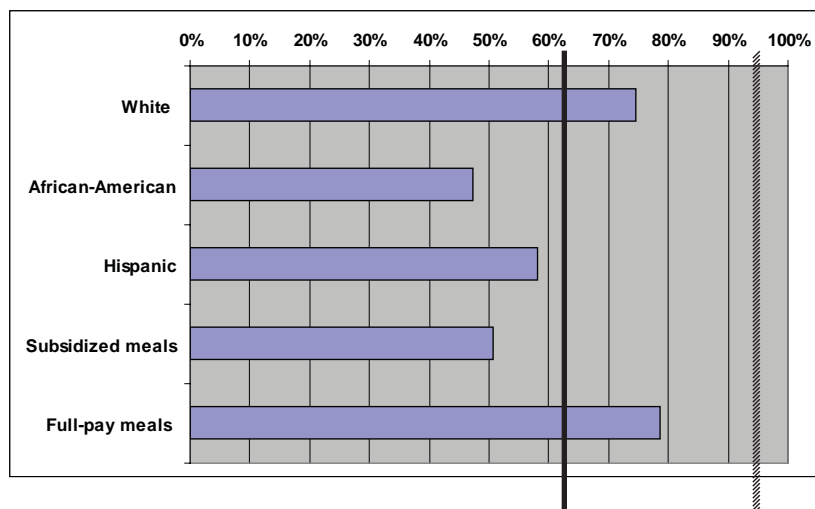

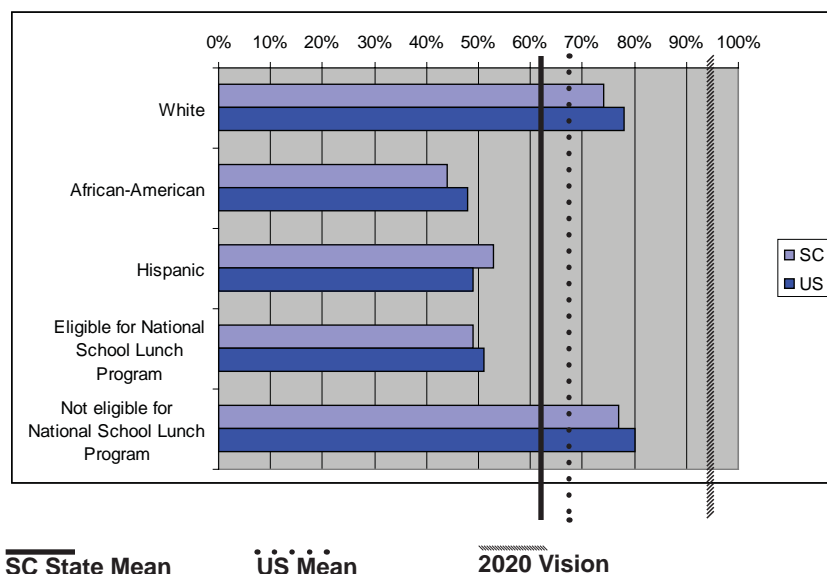

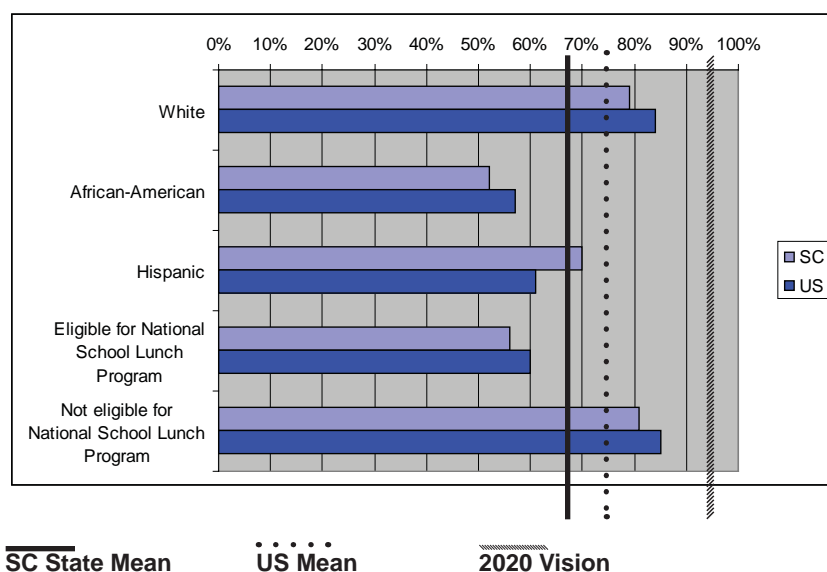

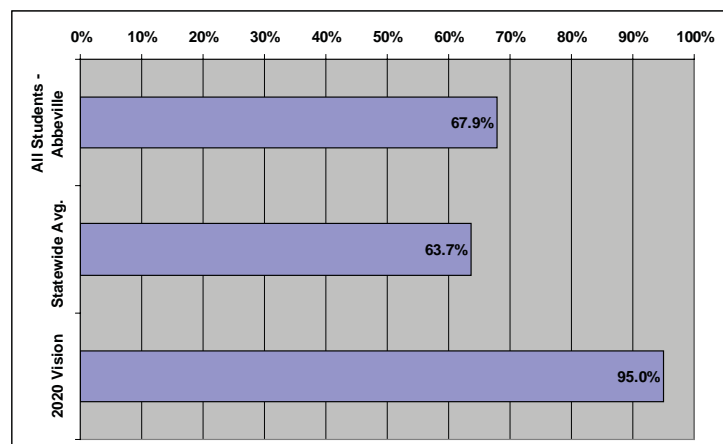

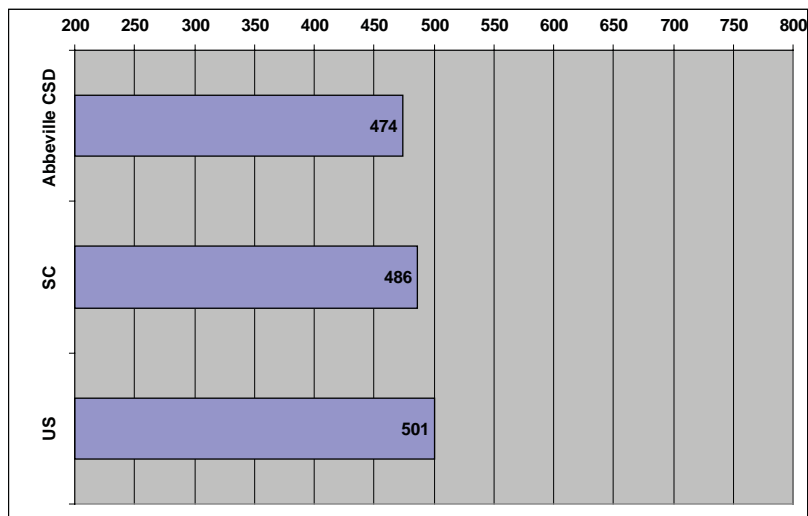

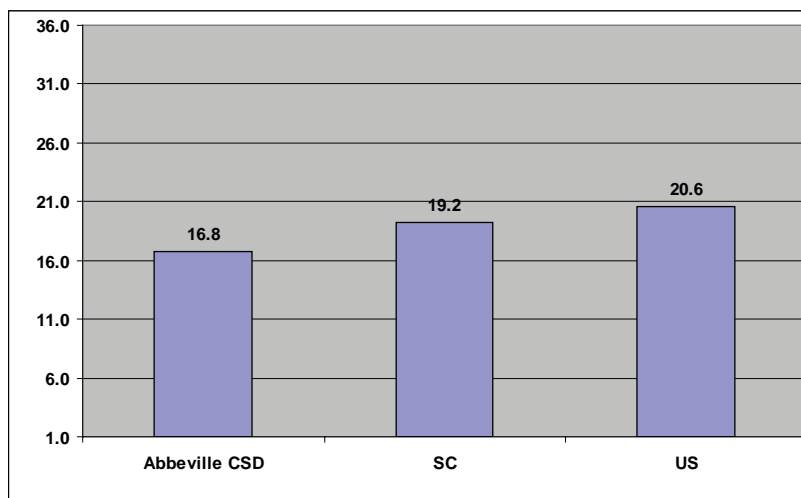

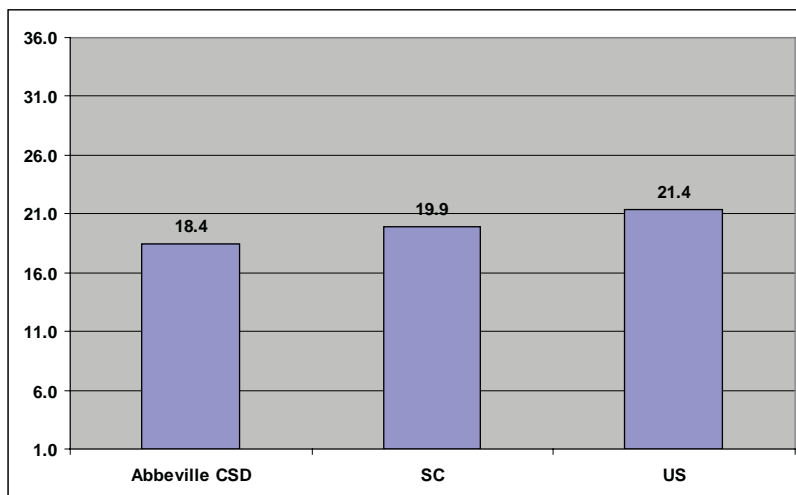
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

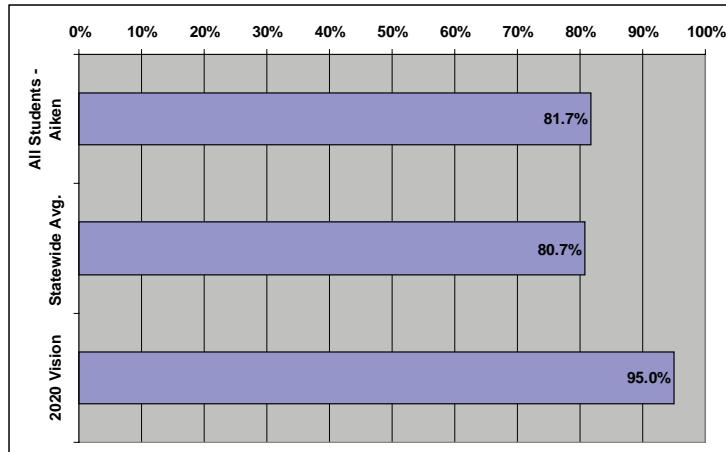

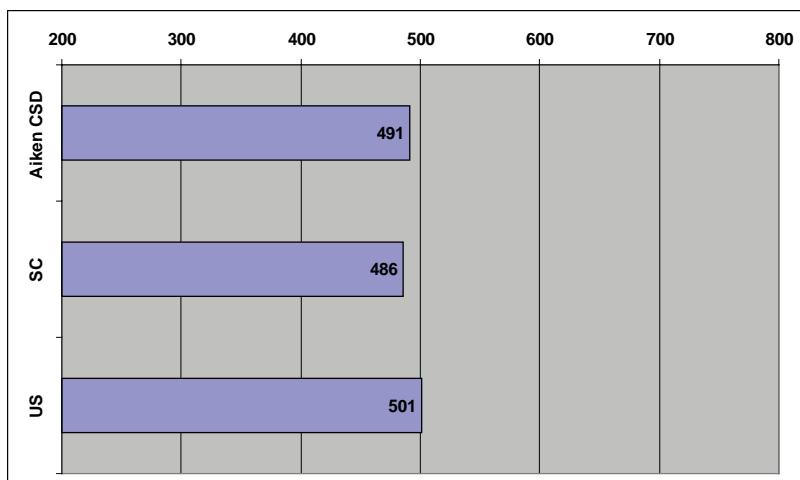

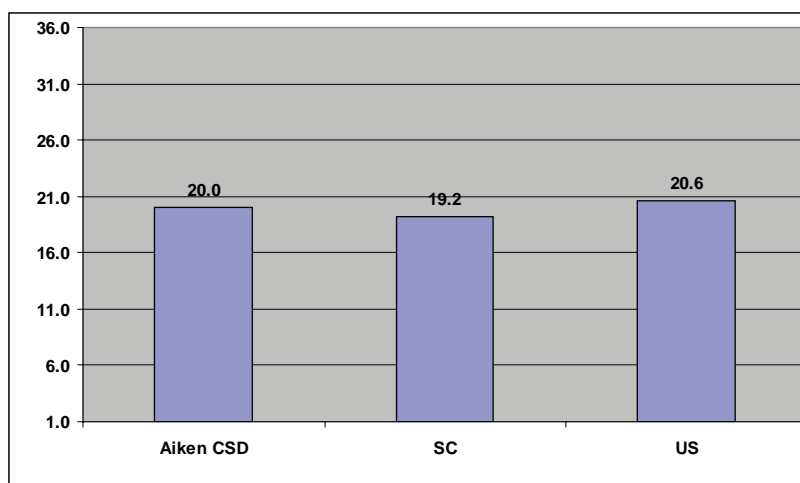

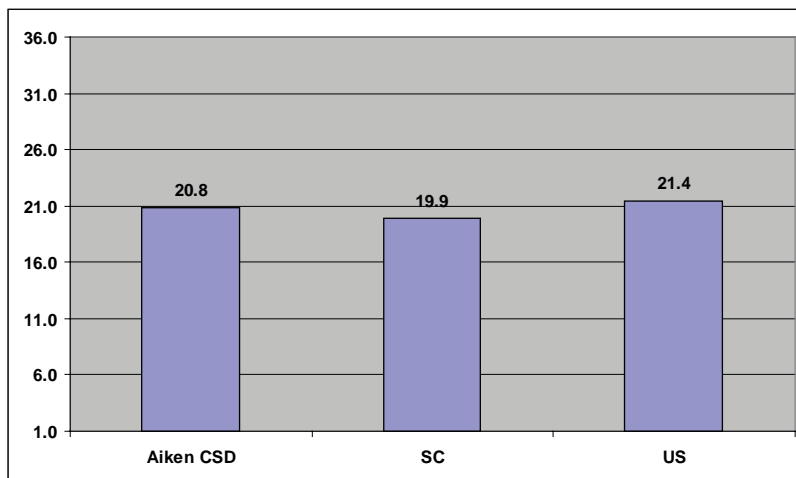
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

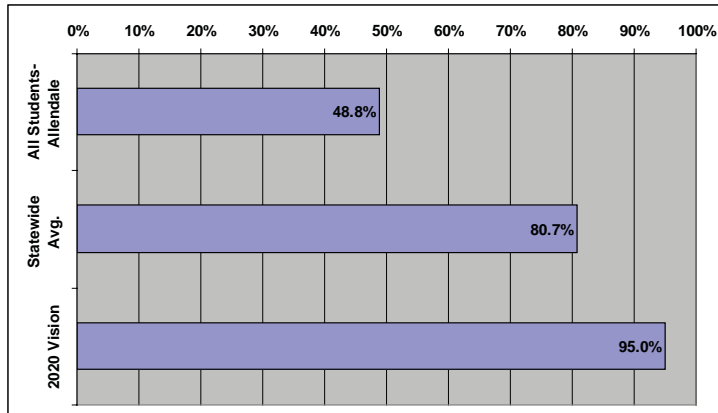

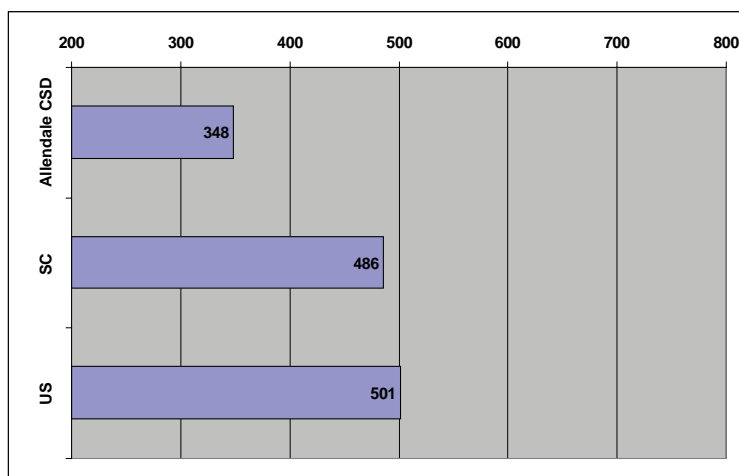

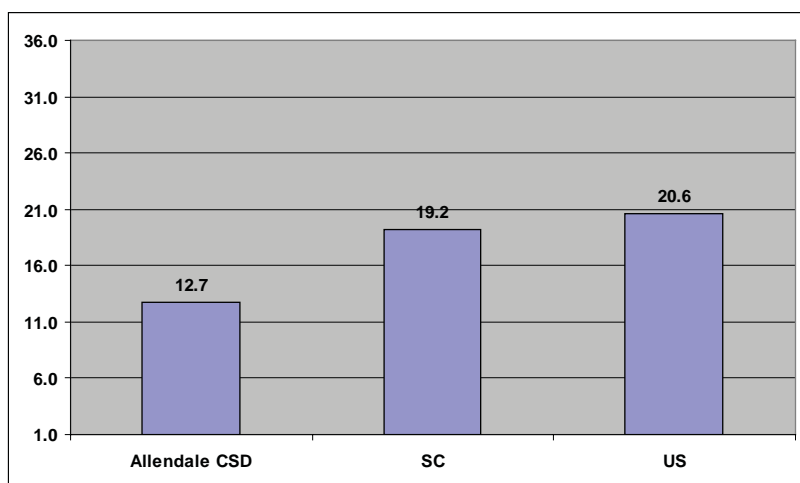
Average performance on 2010 SAT, Critical Reading*

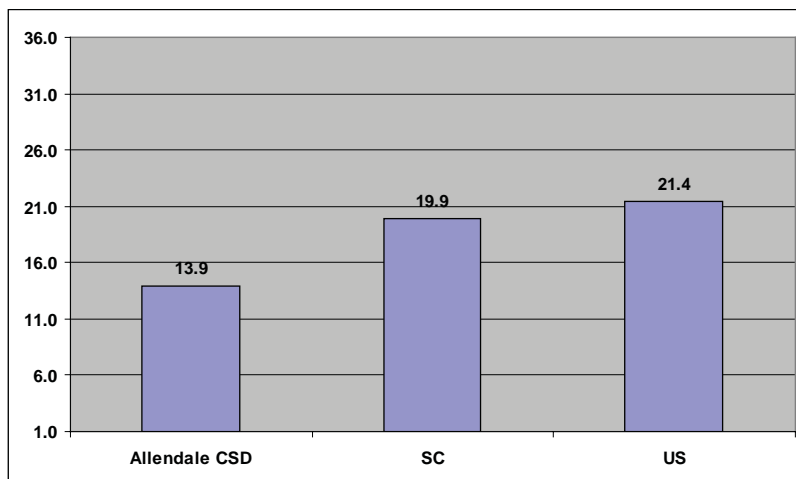
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

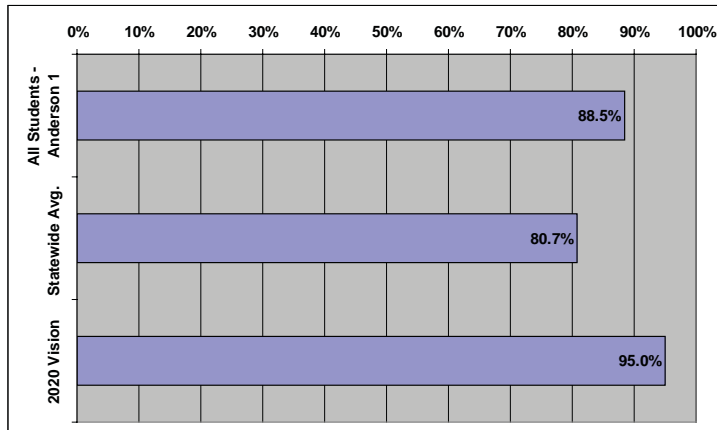

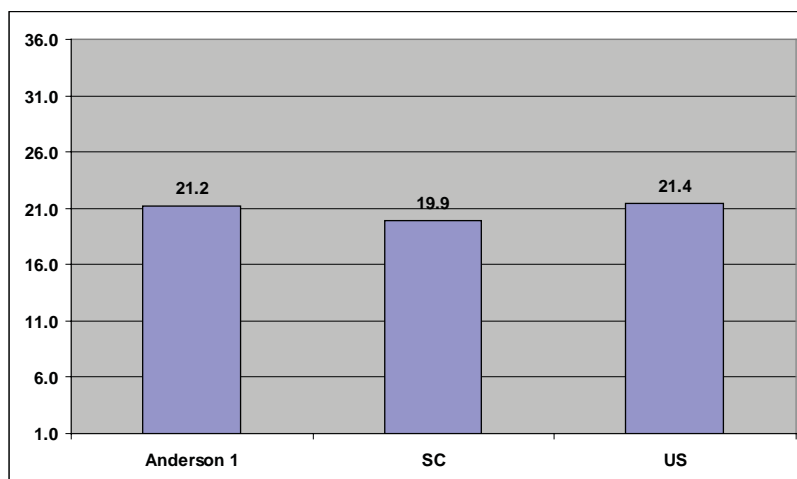
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

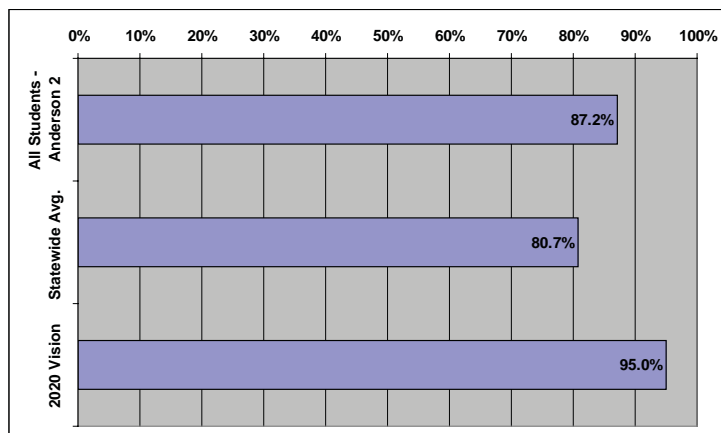

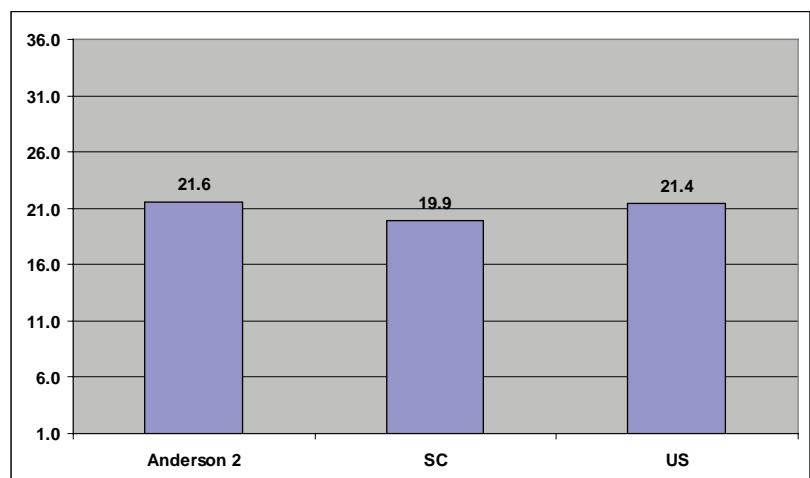
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

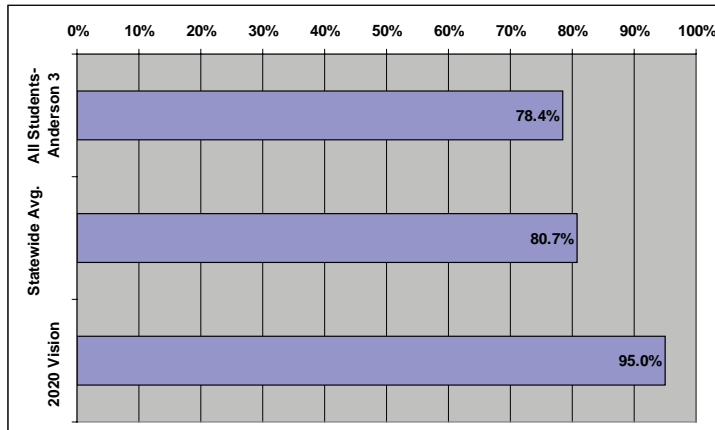

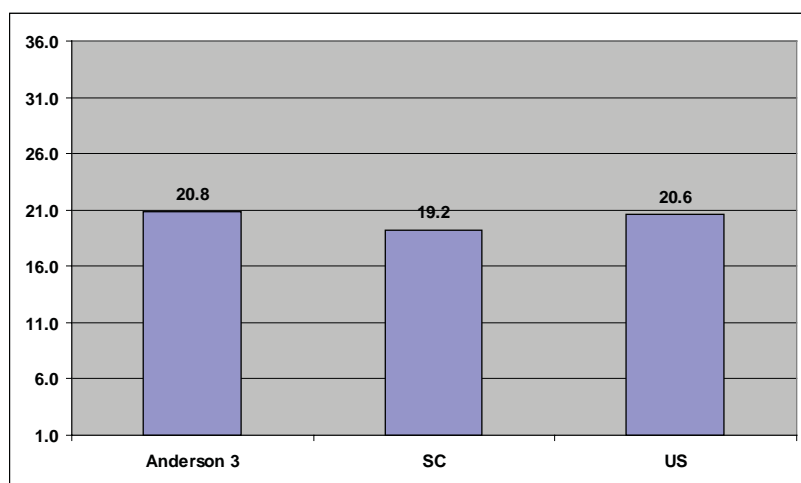

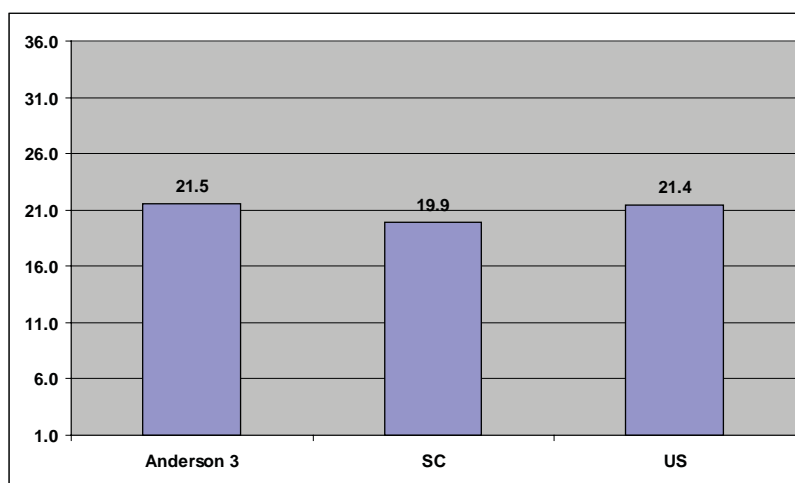
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

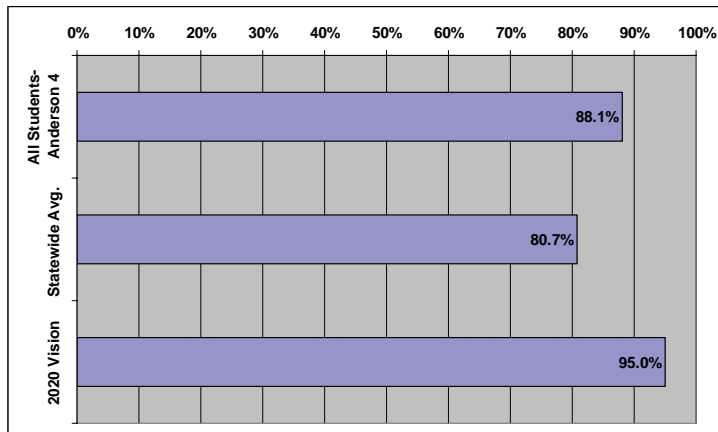

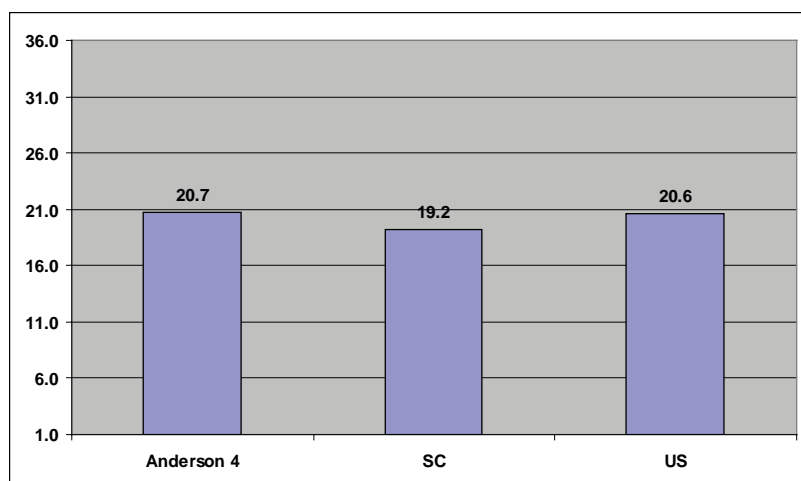
Average performance on 2010 SAT, Critical Reading*

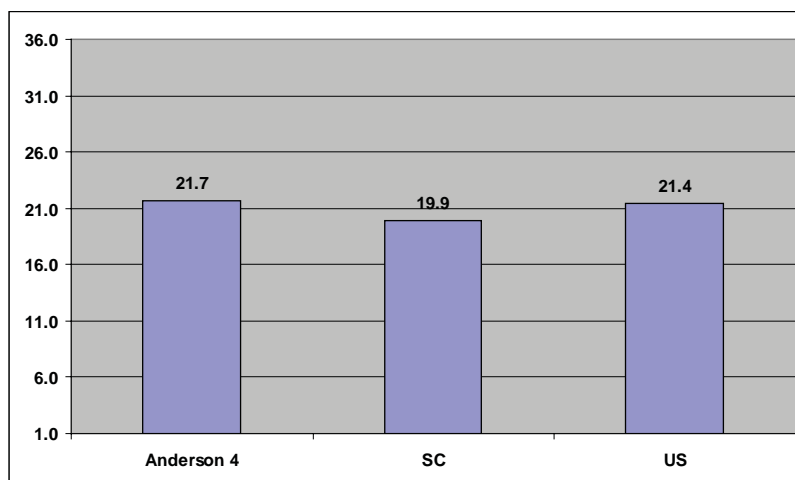
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

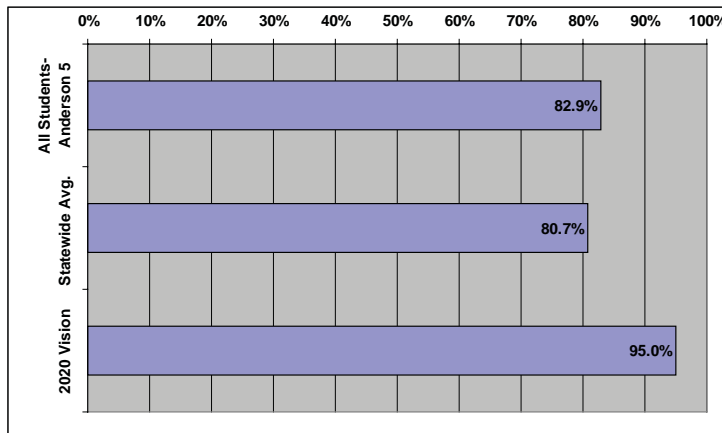

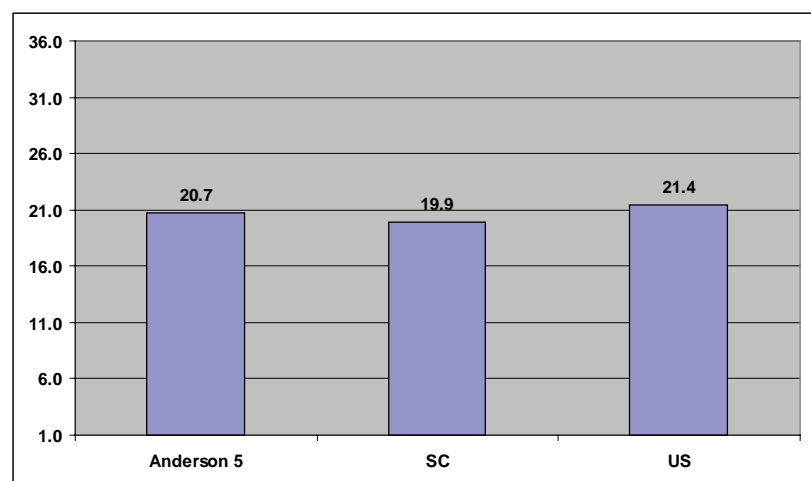
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

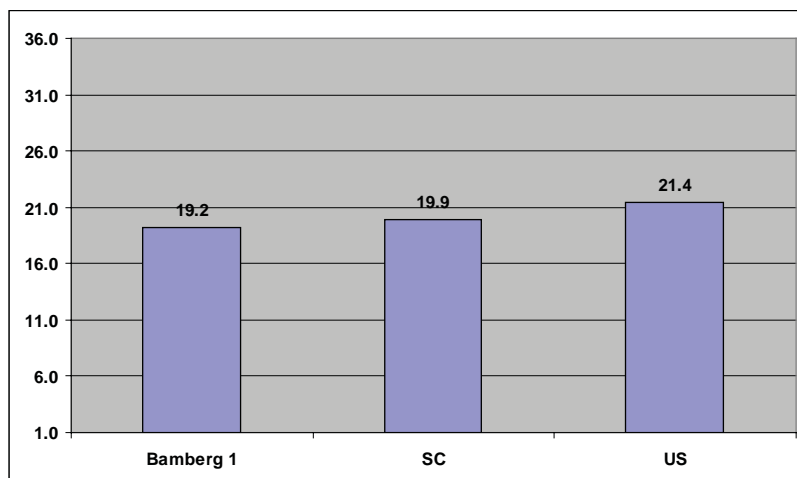
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

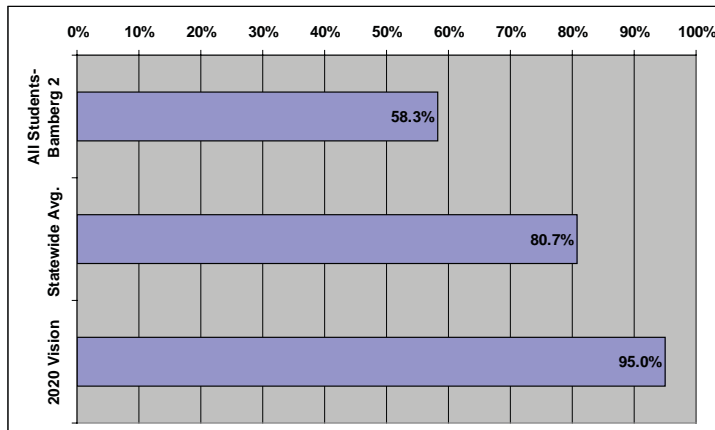

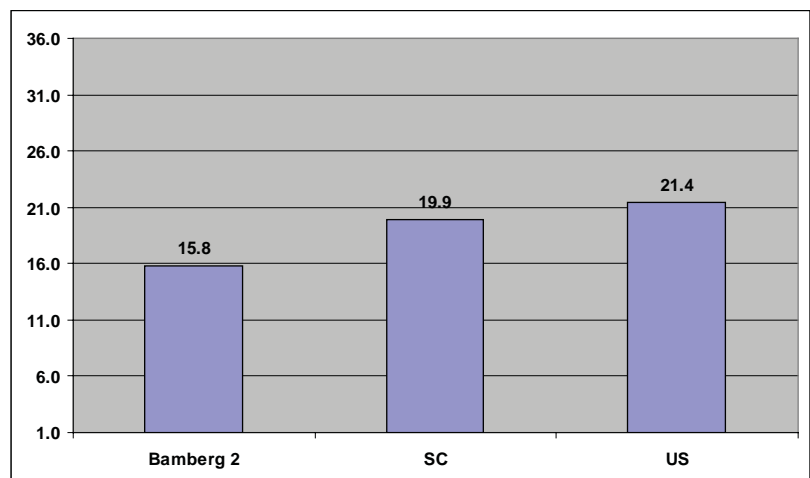

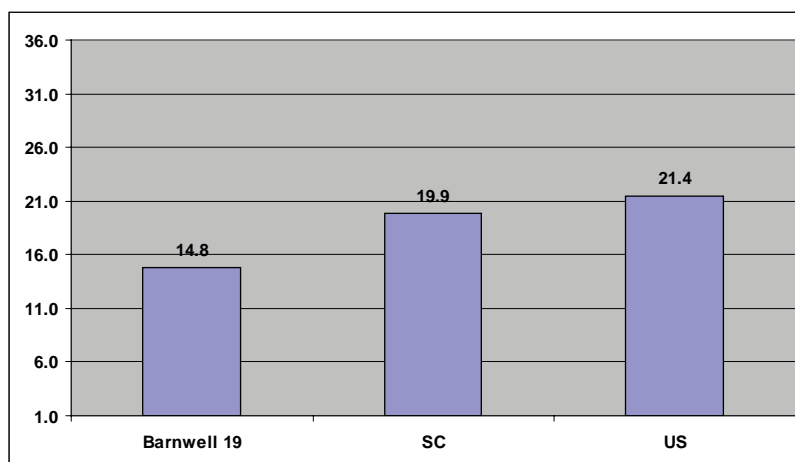
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

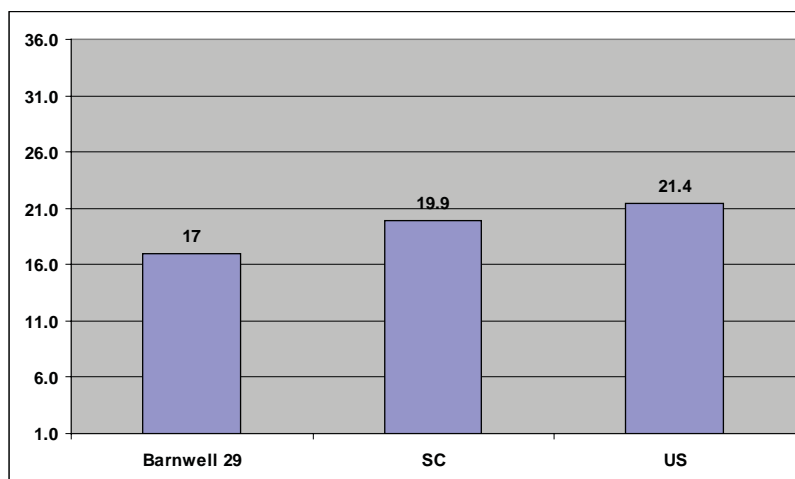

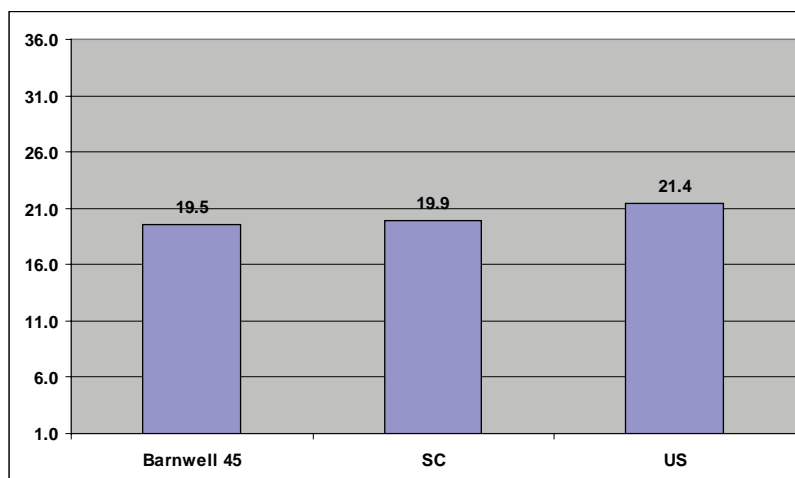

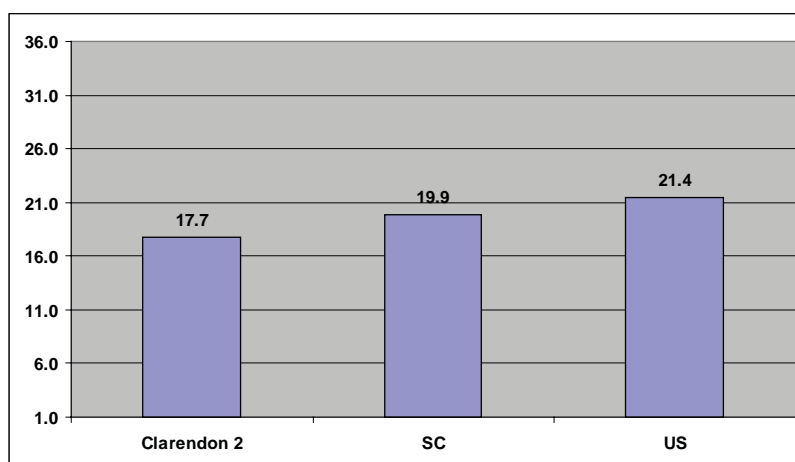
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

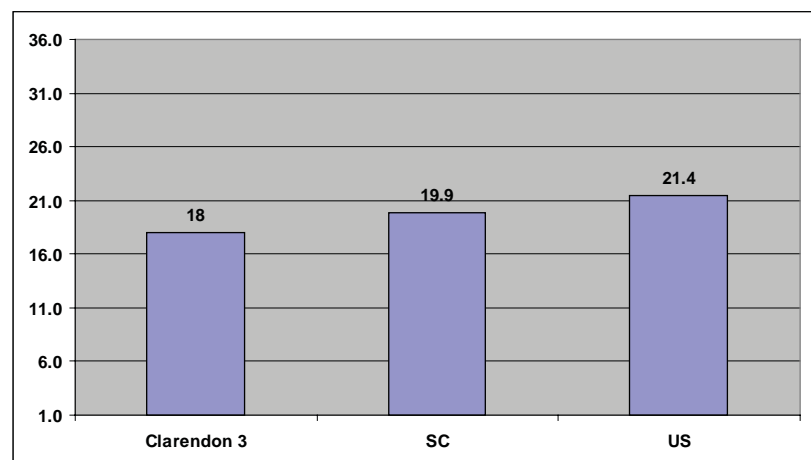
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

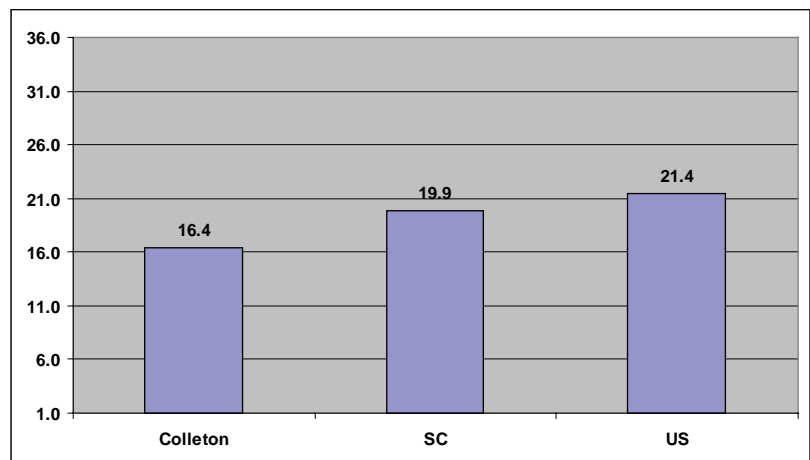
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

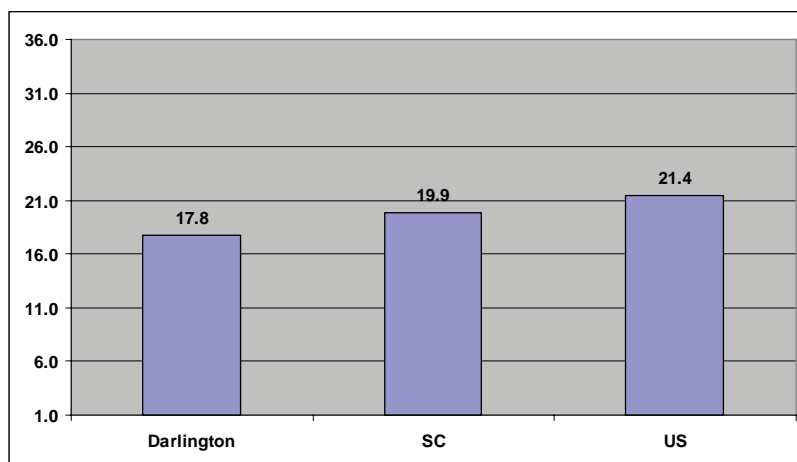
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

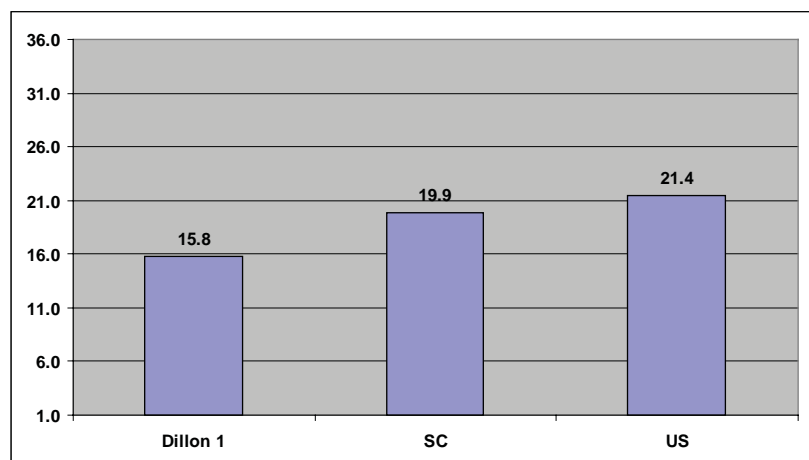
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

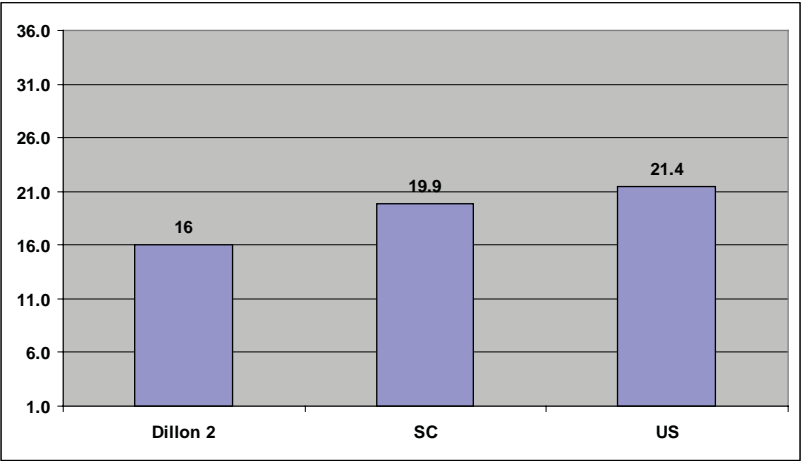
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

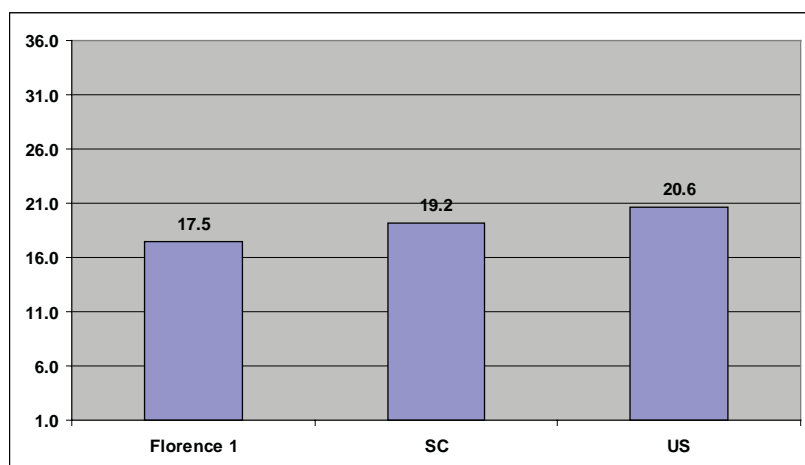

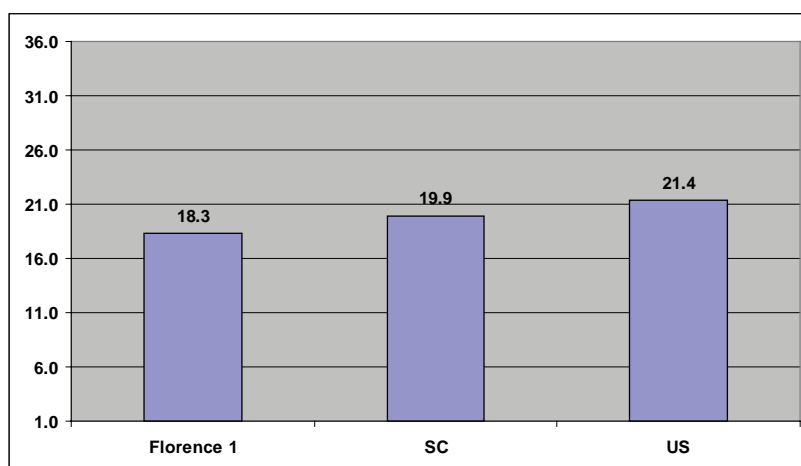
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

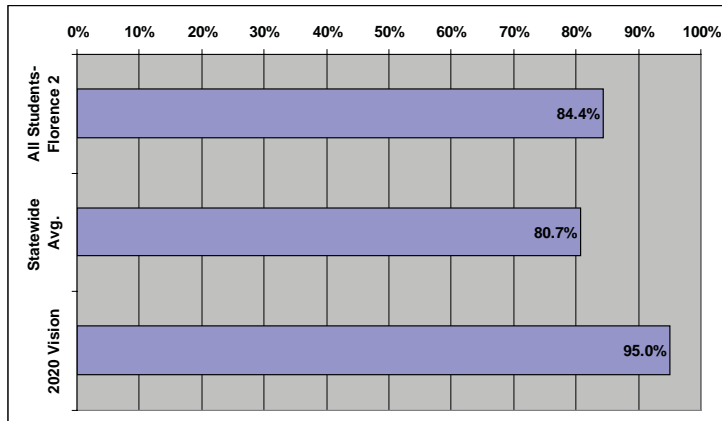

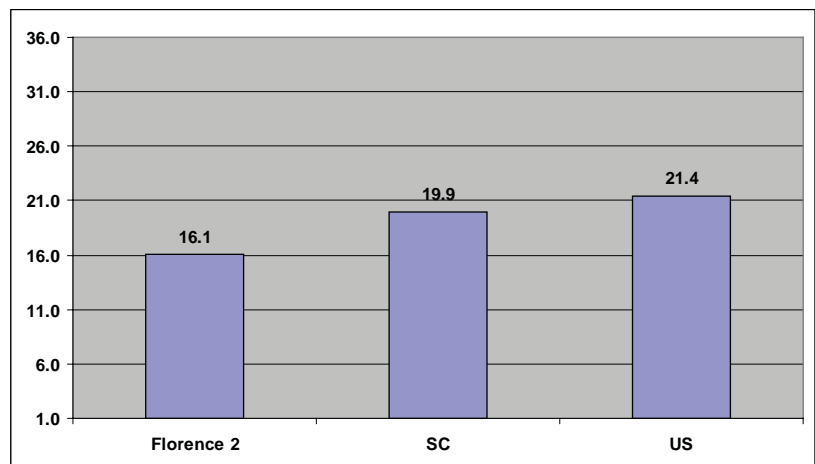
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

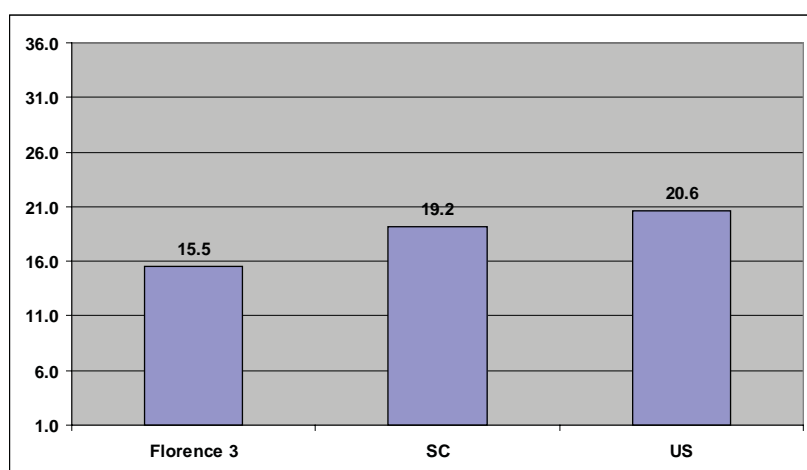

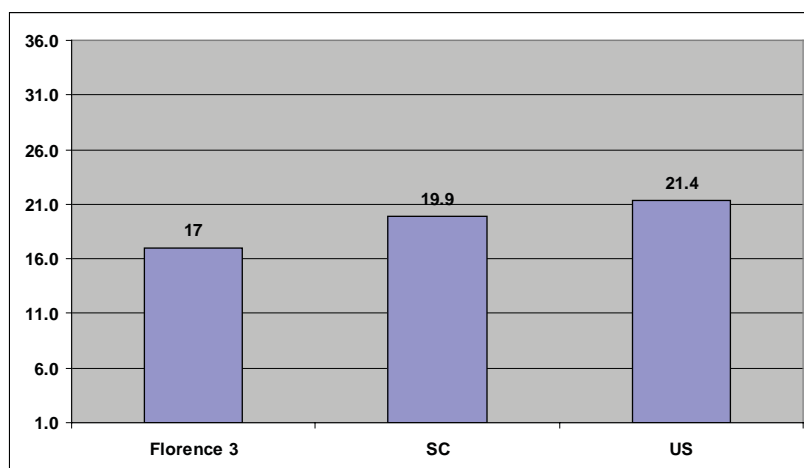
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

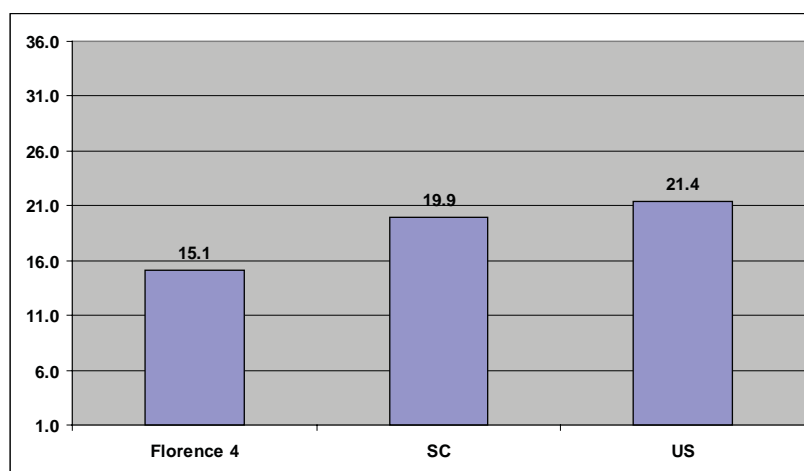
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

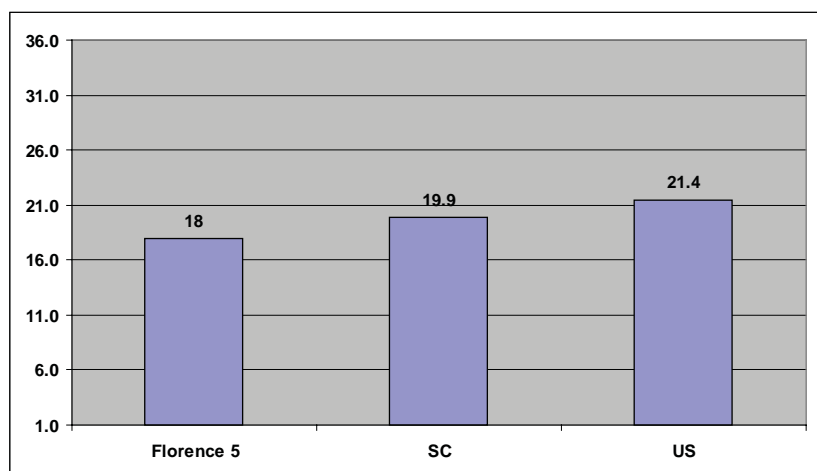
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

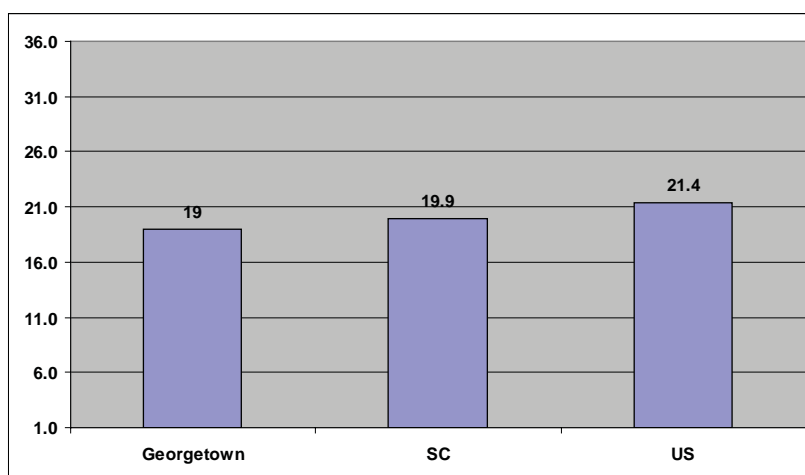

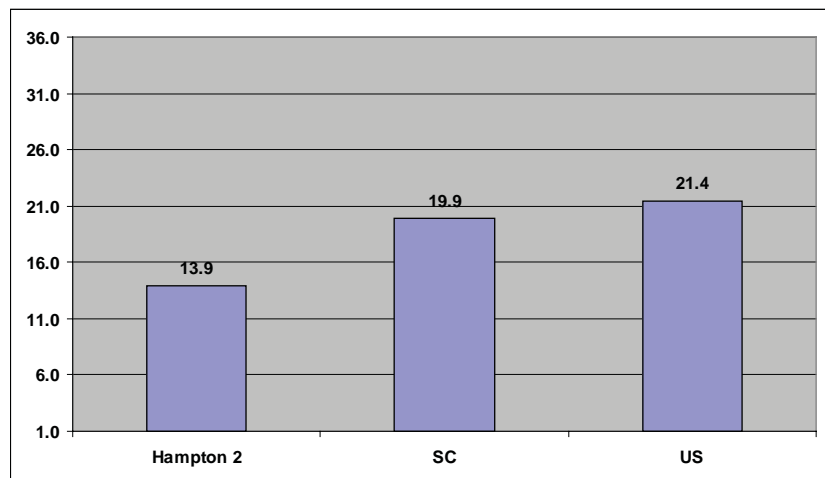
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

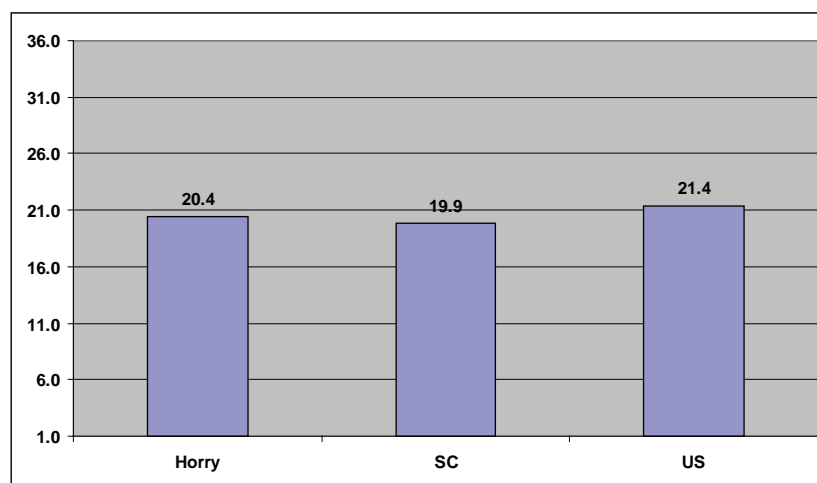
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

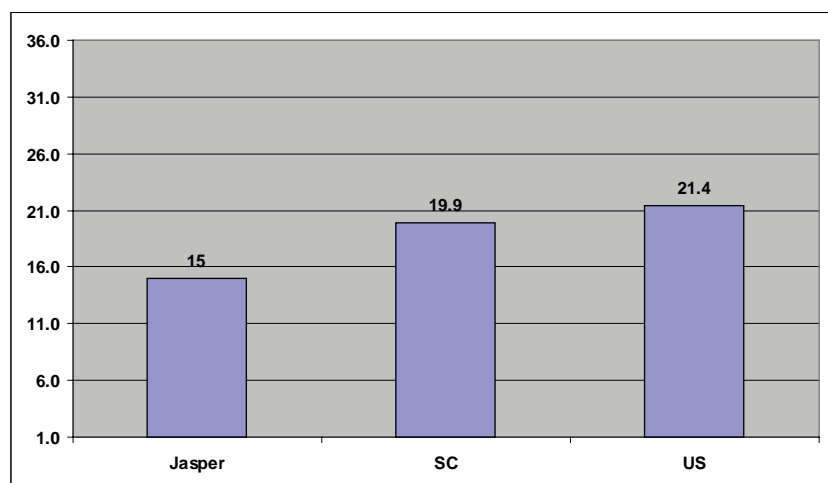
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

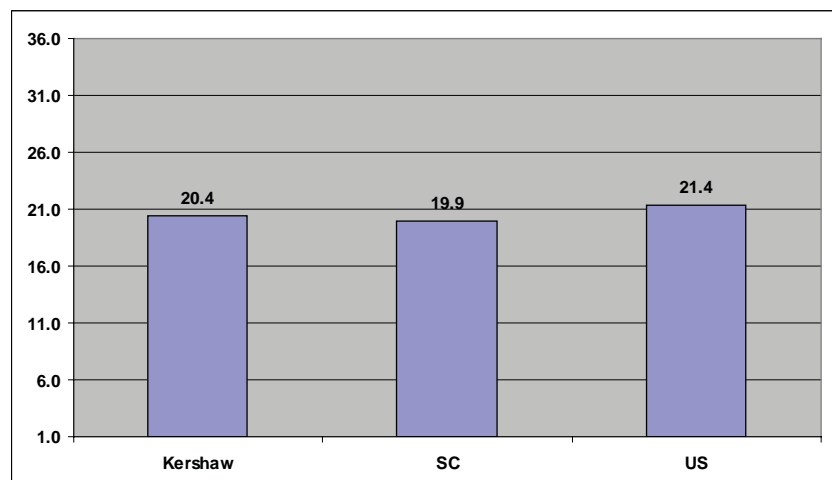
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

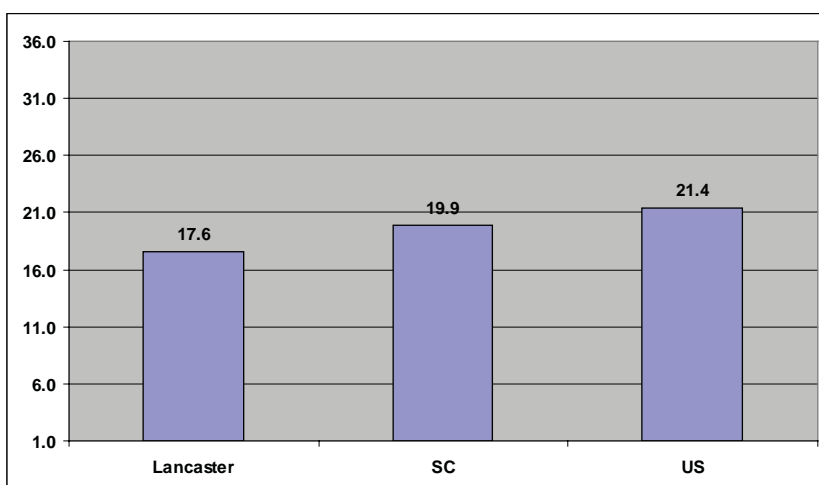
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

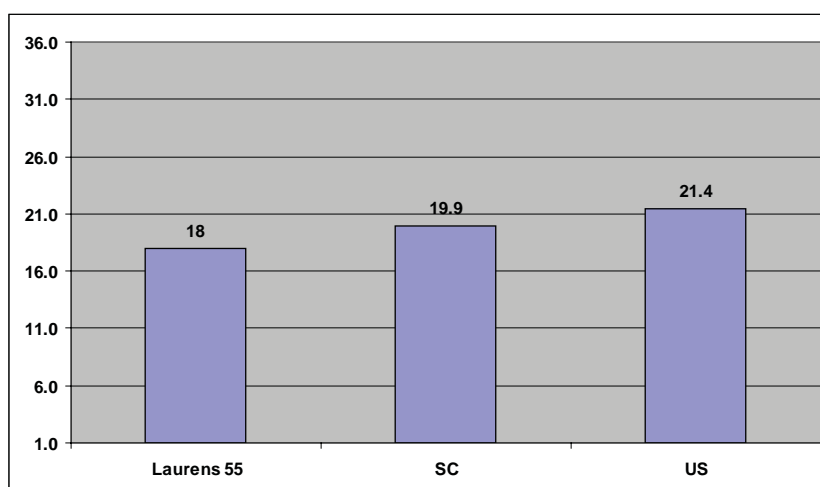
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

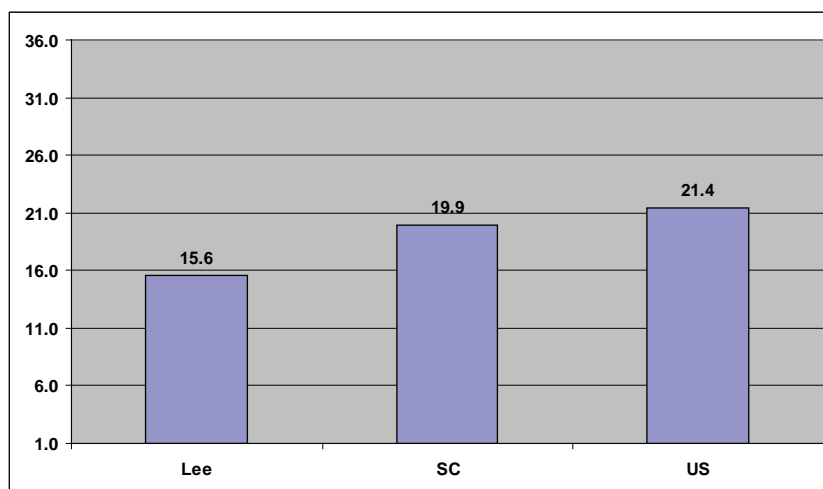
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

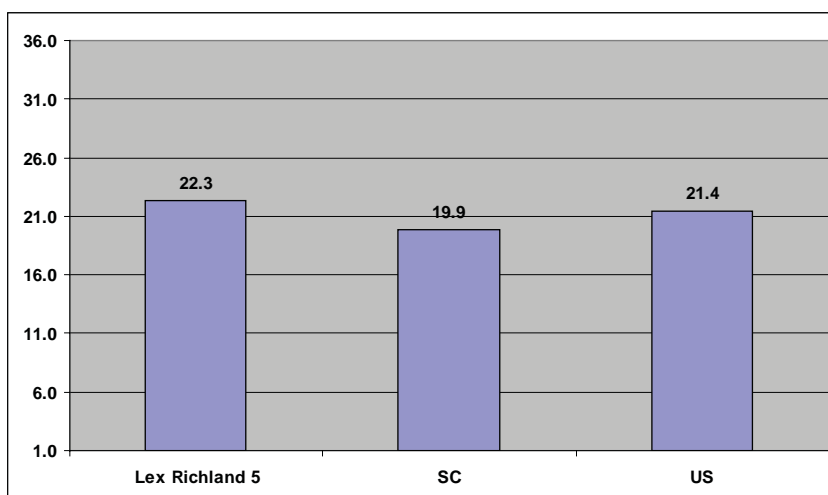
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

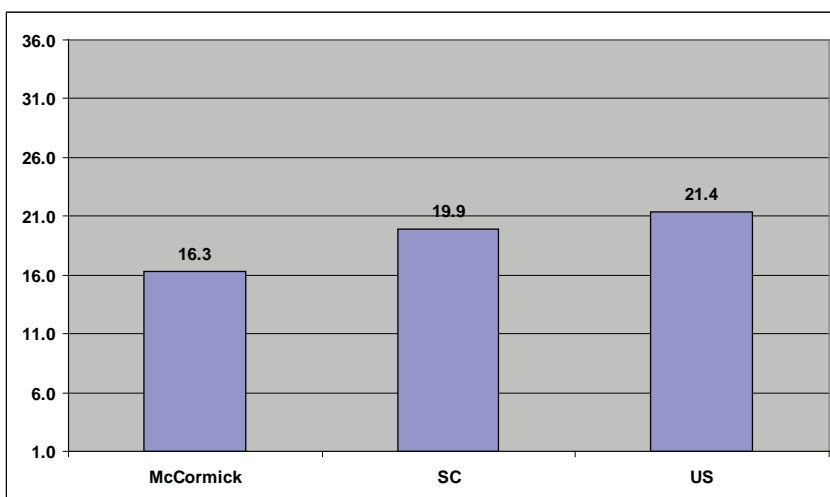

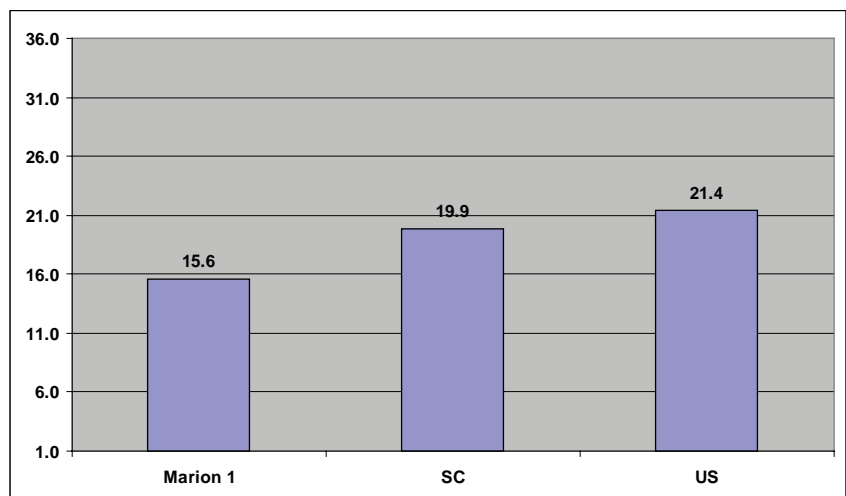

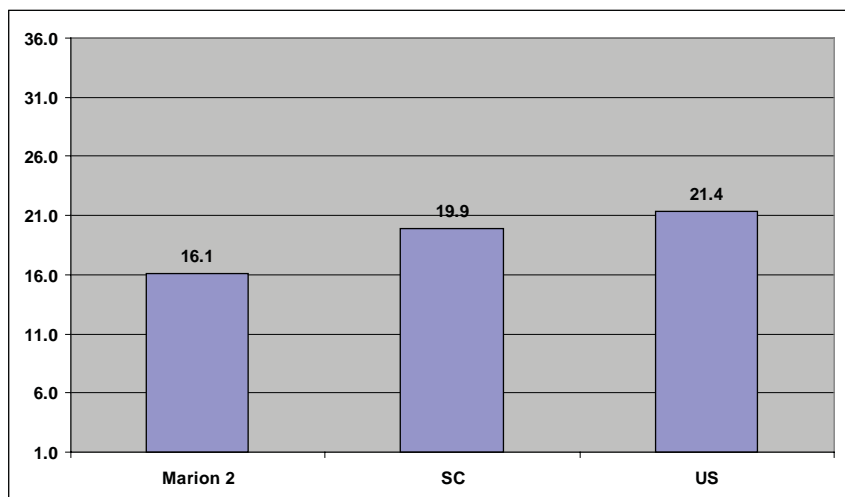
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

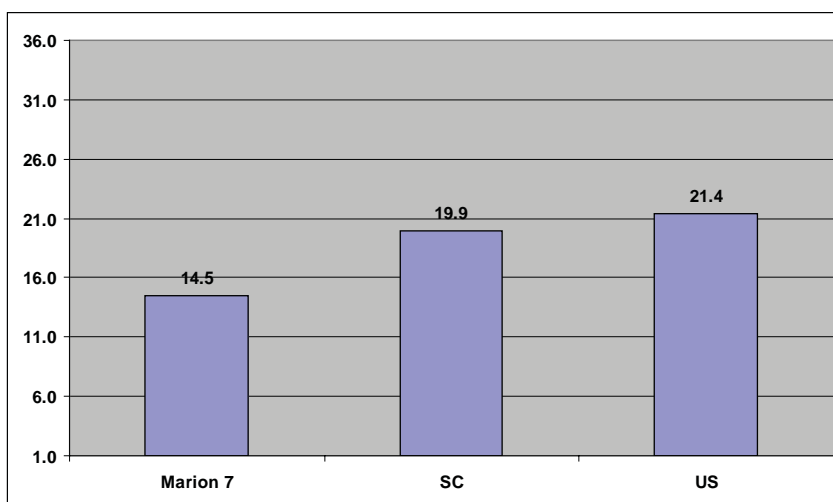

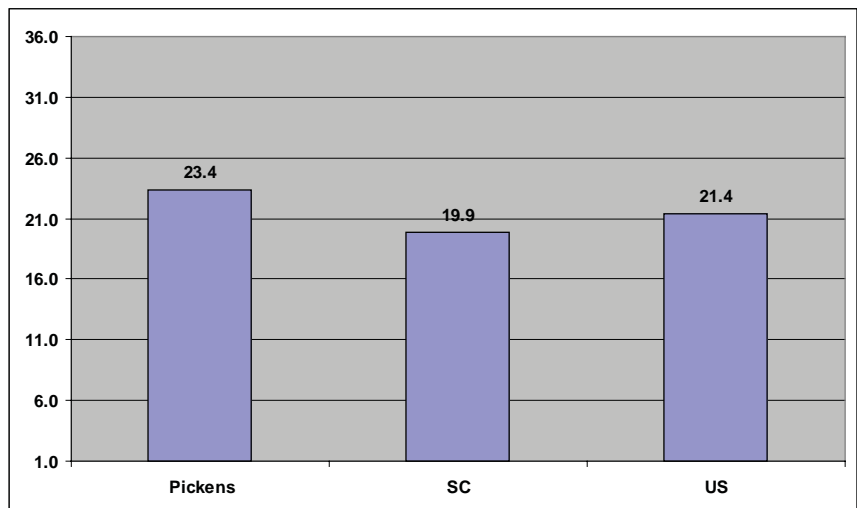
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

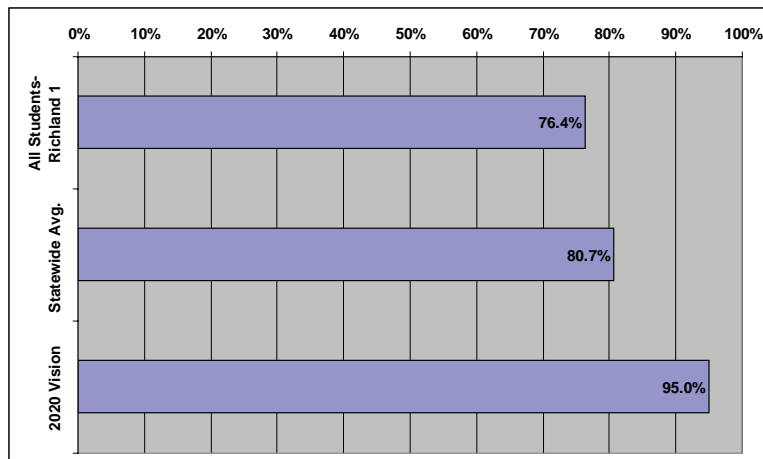

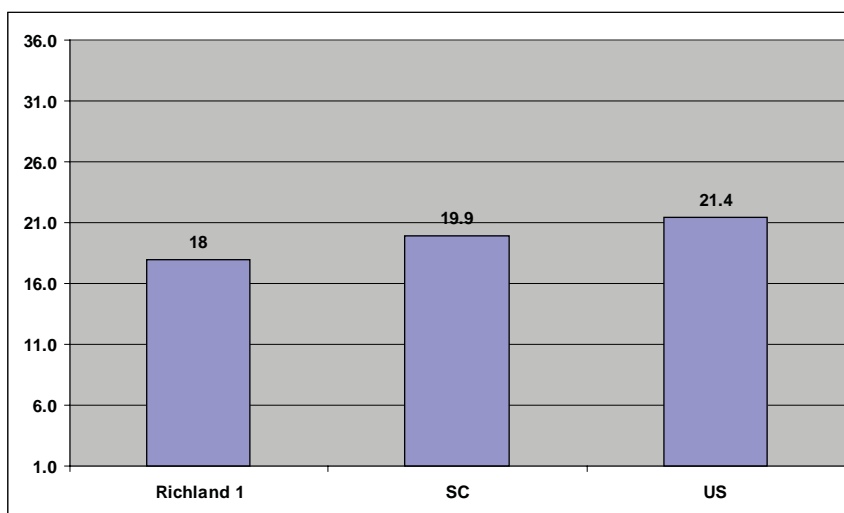
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

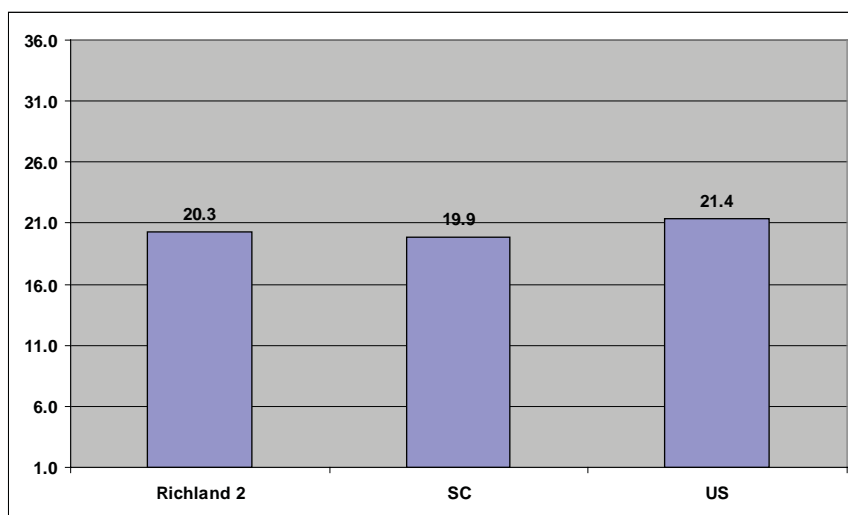
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

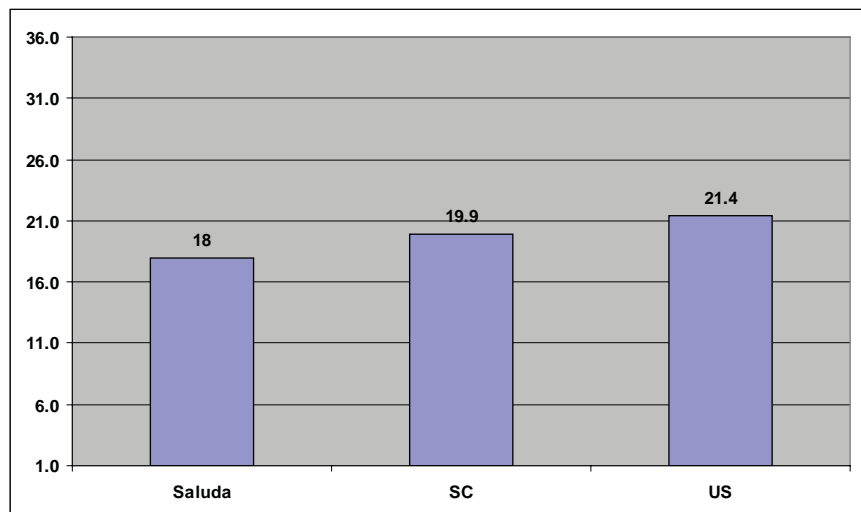
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

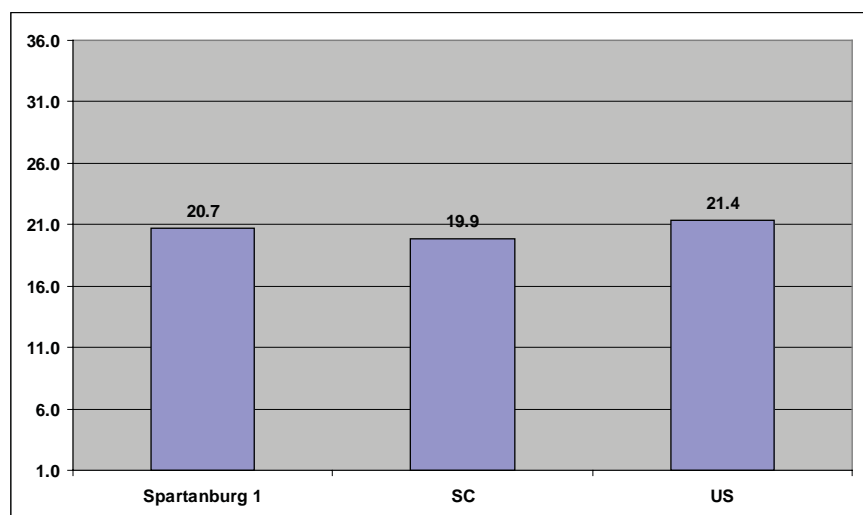
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

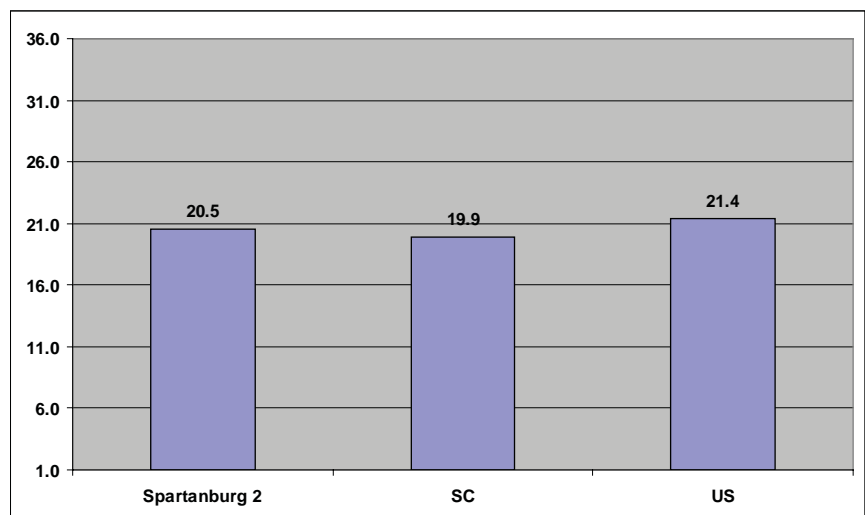
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

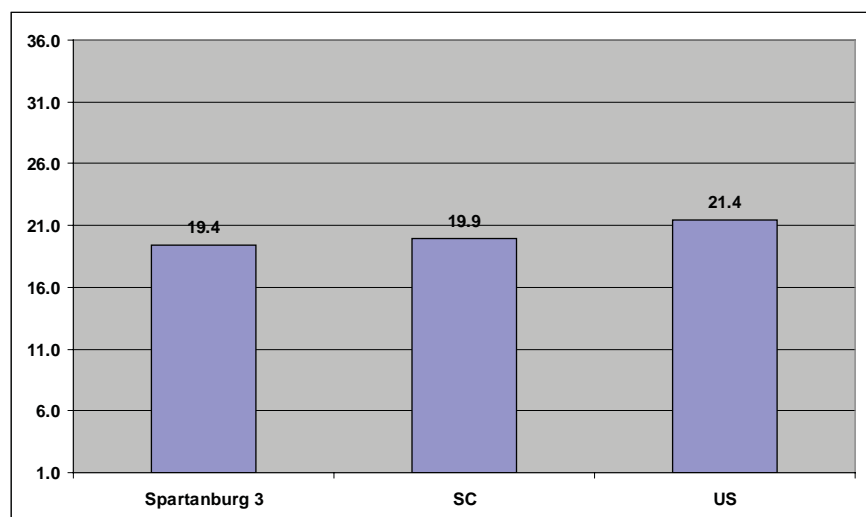
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

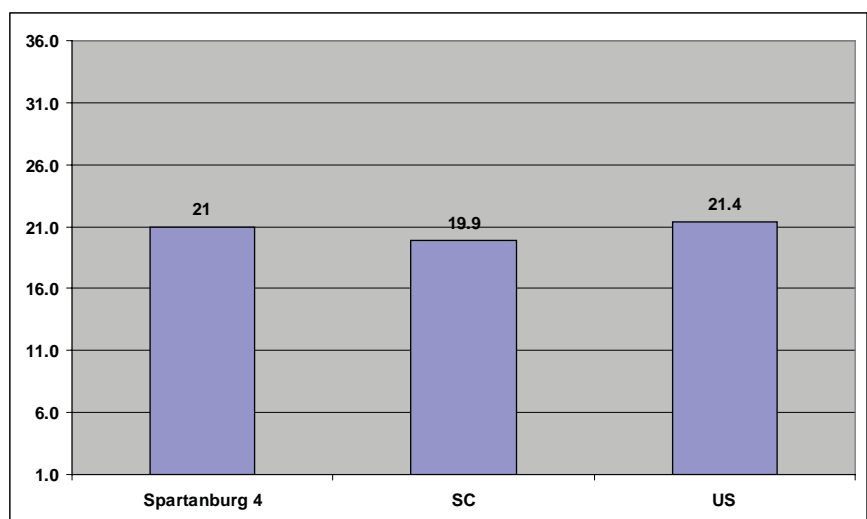

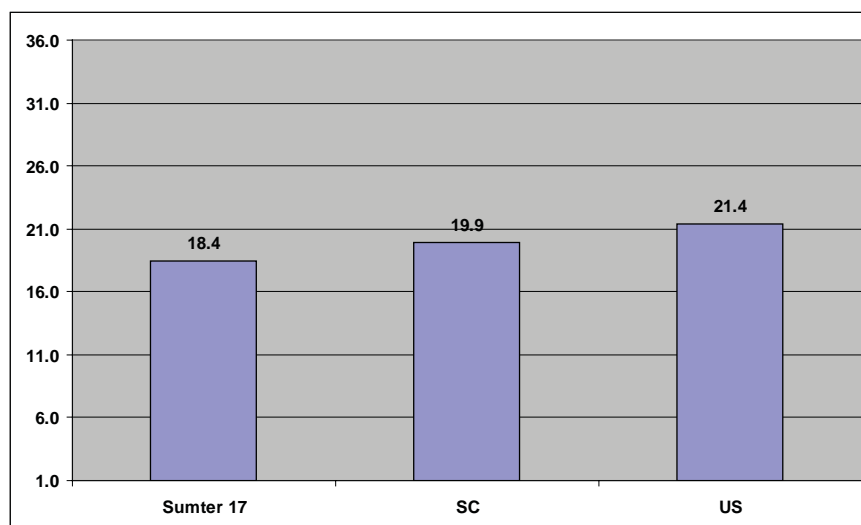
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

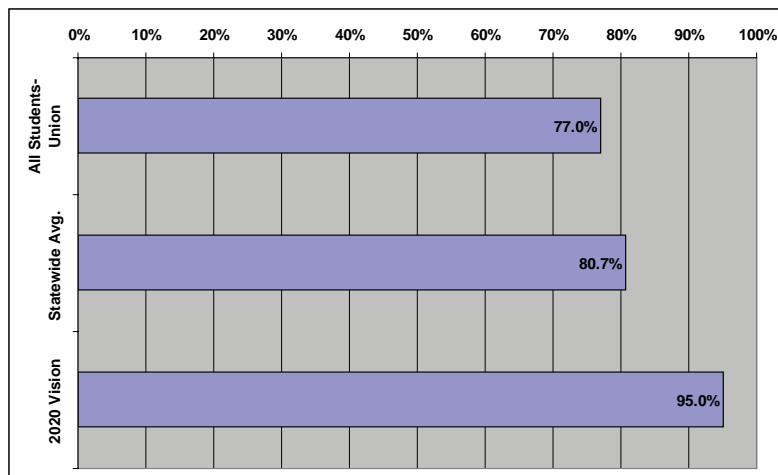

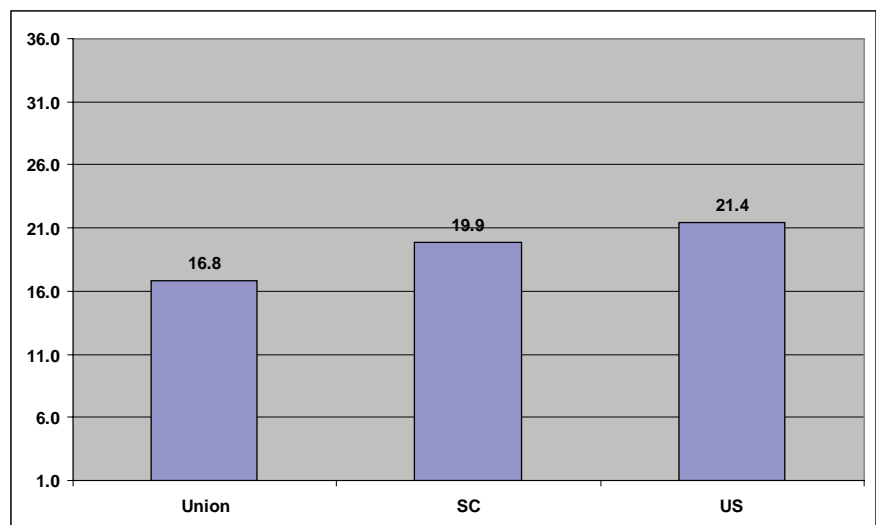
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

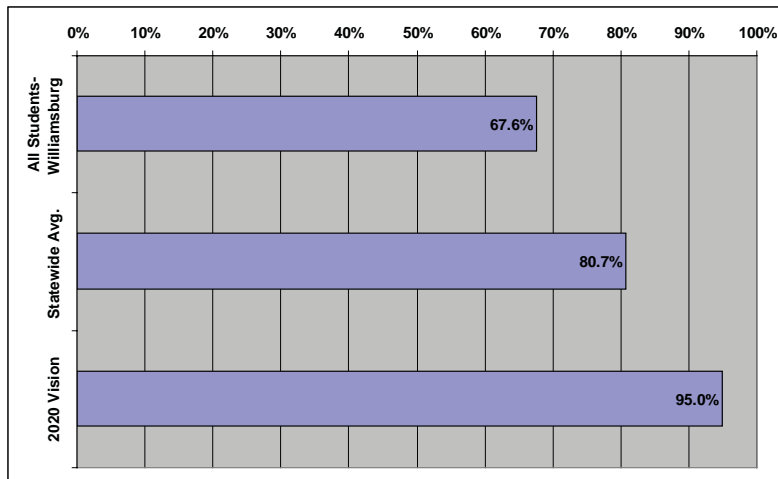

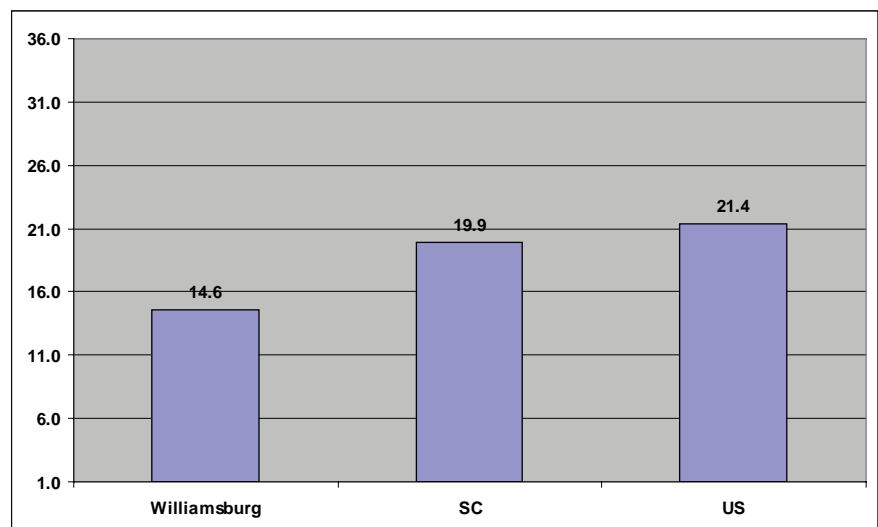
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

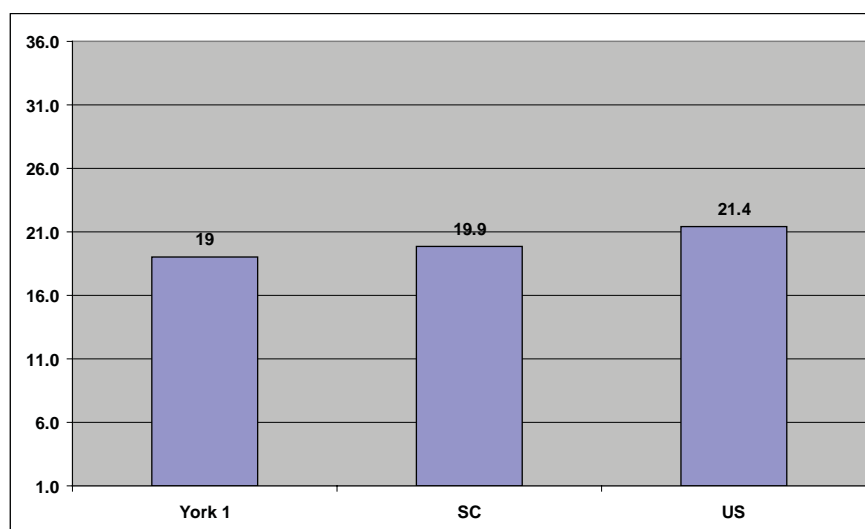
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

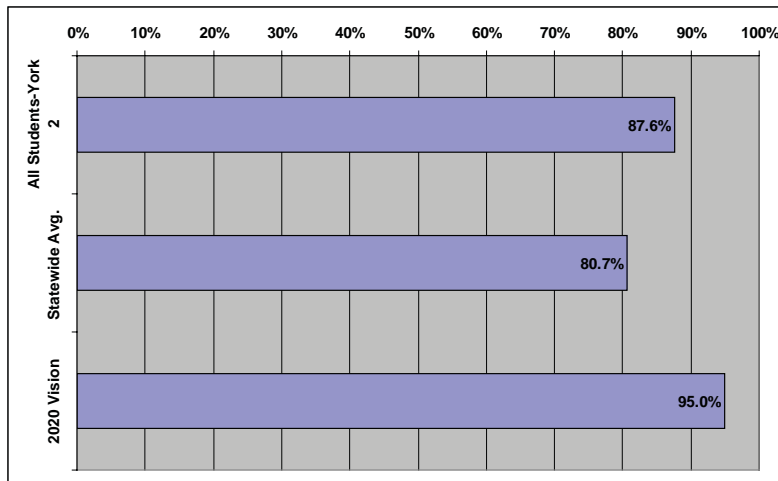

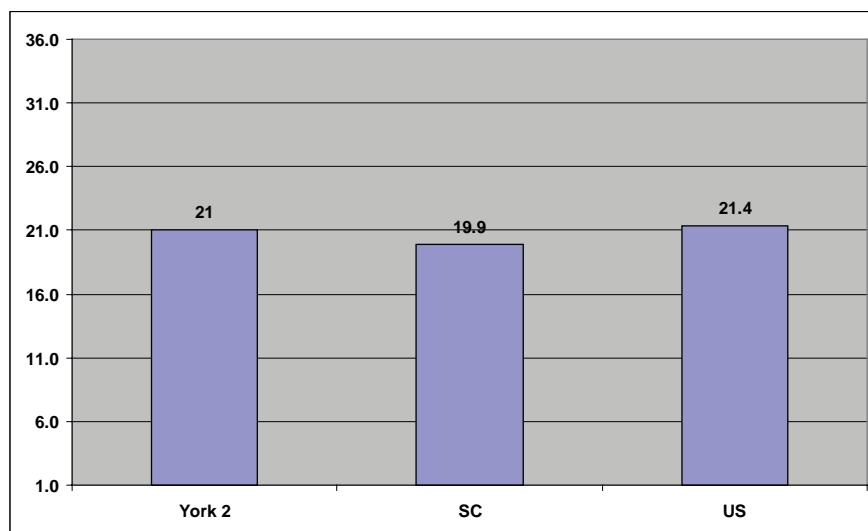
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**

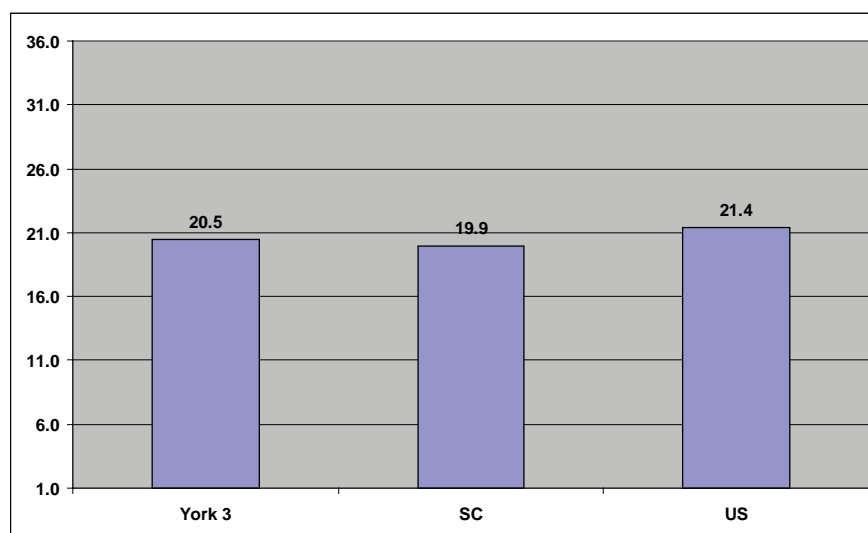
Average performance on 2010 ACT, English**
