Gwen,

I have been in touch with Erika Mars at region II adoptions. I contacted her as directed in a correspondence dated June 29 which contained a copy of my client's agreement to accept placement of Jace. The correspondence requested I contact Ms. Mars to obtain the paperwork necessary to file the complaint for adoption. To my knowledge, no official certificate of placement has been provided (at least I have not seen a copy). When I last spoke with Ms. Mars, she indicated she had received paperwork to start the adoption process, would be sending it to your office for signatures, and then I would receive correspondence with the signed certificate of placement and other materials for filing the adoption action. I have not yet received these materials.

I know we are under statutory time lines to proceeding with the adoption. My client's are anxious to make Jace a permanent member of their family. Please advise what documentation you need from me, if any, and when I could expect the materials from DSS necessary to file the complaint for adoption.

I greatly look forward to the opportunity to work with you, and I appreciate your assistance.

They notified me that Jace Lane's placement agreement was approved on June 29, 2016. Under South Carolina State Law a complaint for adoption has to be filed within 60 days of the placement agreement. To date, after forty one days, a complaint for adoption has not been filed.
