Hello Becca,

I wanted to let the governor know of the calls we have been receiving the last two days from the people of North Augusta (Murphy Village). On yesterday afternoon, we started receiving a high volume of calls requesting the six girls that have been placed in DSS custody be returned home since no allegations of abuse have been founded. We received approximately 101 calls. Today the calls continued at a much lower rate,

but it was noted that DSS and Sled were there today going through the mailboxes of the residents and DSS is trying to take a sickly child into custody. Of the twelve calls today, two of them were from people asking that the children not be returned.
