Single family, frame residence with brick pier and concrete block foundation; rectangular plan and front-gabled roof. Central door flanked by paired six-over-six, double-hung, wooden sash windows on either side; hipped roof porch supported by simple square posts. The side elevations of the house each have a single six-over-six, double-hung, wooden sash window. The exterior of the house was originally covered with horizontal wooden weatherboard siding, which is visible on the side elevations, but the front elevation has been covered with faux stone paneling. Visible raftertails along eaves
