The ships of **Hurtigruten** navigate 1,500 miles of spectacular Norwegian coastline, exploring majestic fjords and picturesque towns. The line began making these voyages in 1893. Today, 11 vessels offer daily departures from Bergen in the south and Kirkenes in the north.

Each season along Norway's coast has its own special character. In summer, for example, guests experience the true meaning of the Land of the Midnight Sun. North of the Arctic Circle, the sun stays above the horizon around the clock. A record 23 million passengers are expected to take a cruise this year, according to an annual "state of the industry" report released last week by the Cruise Lines International Association (CLIA), a trade organization with 62 member lines. That's about a 4 percent increase over last year.

Twenty-two new ships are scheduled to launch in 2015, including oceangoing and river vessels, representing a total investment of more than \$4 billion.

Cruise ships call at nearly 1,000 ports around the world, according to CLIA, but the **Caribbean** continues to be the world's most popular cruise destination. More than a third of the global cruise ship capacity is deployed in the region.

Carnival's largest ship to date -- the 4,980-guest **Carnival Vista** -- now is open for booking. It debuts in May 2016 with some brand-new seagoing features, such as the first IMAX theater on a cruise ship and the line's first onboard brewery.

Also new: the aqua park's Kaleid-O-Slide, where you can jump into a one- or two-person inflatable raft for a twisting, turning trip down a waterslide. At the SkyRide, passengers can pedal hanging recumbent bikes along a track suspended 150 feet above the ocean.

New staterooms will be rolled out. Havana Cabanas will have patios that face the Deck 5 promenade. Family Harbor cabins accommodating up to five people will be situated in a dedicated family zone that has its own lounge stocked with big-screen TVs and games; it also will serve daily breakfast and snacks.

The Carnival Vista will spend its inaugural season in the Mediterranean, then move to Miami for four- to eight-night Caribbean sailings. [Click here](#) for discounted rates.

Luxury line **Regent** has announced the first sailings of the upcoming **Seven Seas Explorer**. The 750-guest
