Dear Governor Haley:

This is a follow-up to my letter dated November 17, 2014, which as of this date I have not received a response from your office.

Three representatives from SCDNR met me and my husband at our property in Manning on December 12, 2014 to discuss the problems we are having with deer dogging on our property. They told us that until the law is changed there is nothing they can do. They said 9 out of 10 calls they receive are complaints about deer dogging.

The violators are aware that there is nothing that law enforcement can do which leads to them bullying landowners and doing as they please. The SCDNR representatives know who the violators are and do not have too many good things to say about them. The SCDNR employees are very frustrated that they cannot do anything to help the landowners.

Until our representatives change the law the landowners have no protection against these violators doing as they please to our property.

I am asking that you please help us and consider fighting for the citizens of the counties effected by this problem (Clarendon, Sumter Bamberg, and Orangeburg to name a few). I am sure that most of the Senators are not affected with this problem since their counties probably do not allow deer dogging. It is not a good thing with the growth in these communities.
